Who is JESUS? Connecting to Him as The Jewish MESSIAH

(BOISE, Id)—The Old Testament records a number of pre-Bethlehem appearances of CHRIST JESUS (commonly referred to as Theophanies or Christophanies).

A Theophany or Christophany is a visible appearance of God in the Old Testament period, often, but not always, in human form. The Pre-Incarnate CHRIST JESUS (physically visible and interactive appearances in the Old Testament as The LORD GOD, MELCHIZEDEK possibly, The LORD, GOD, or as an ANGEL OF THE LORD).

Every Christophany or Theophany in the Old Testament wherein God takes on human form foreshadows the incarnation, where God took the form of a man to live among us as Emmanuel, "God with us" (KJV Matthew 1:18-25:

The Gateway Pundit wrote about Dr. Anthony Harper in September during the fall of Afghanistan and the thousands of stranded Americans on the ground there.

Dr. Harper is an investigative journalist with the InterMountain Christian News and Israel news service 'Newsrael.' In September Dr. Harper described how the Biden White House press office started giving him a hard time by restricting his access to the Press Secretary Jennifer Psaki's office after he started asking difficult questions on Biden's historic disaster in Afghanistan. Dr. Harper has been given a permanent White House hard press pass.



Dr. Harper, who has been reporting from the White House for several years, now must have an escort before he addresses Jen Psaki in her office.

Now Dr. Anthony Harper is being pressured by the White House and liberal media inside the room to be vaccinated against his will.

Earlier today at the White House briefing room Dr. Harper was harassed for not being vaccinated.


Working definition of Anti-Semitism

"I oppose all forms of Anti-Semitism, including but not limited to dividing Israel with the establishment of a Palestinian state, assault of Jewish people, business deals with Iran, BDS, funding of Anti-Semitic U.N. agencies like UNRWA and others; defacing Jewish places of worship, business, monuments as well as desecration of cemeteries in Vilnius, Lithuania and elsewhere by building over the graves of the Jewish people. I seek to restore the Jewish cemetery in Vilnius, Lithuania as well as all other Jewish cemeteries to their former glory with gravestones and a fence according to Jewish law and tradition, for no restoration is desecration and violation of religious and human rights of the Jewish nation and especially the descendants of those buried there."

As Christian News Northwest Founder Retires, the Newspaper Gets New Leadership

N E W B E R G, Ore. — Effective with the December 2021 issue, Christian News Northwest founding publisher and editor John Fortmeyer of Newberg has retired and the newspaper is in new hands — longtime Oregon journalist Tim Hirsch is at the helm.

Hirsch, who also publishes the bi-weekly Pacific City Sun (pacificcitysun.com) in Tillamook County, has established a Newberg office for both papers under the brand Salt Media LLC.

A 1994 journalism graduate of the University of Oregon, Hirsch founded the Sun in 2007. His earlier journalism experience included stints as production manager and managing editor for the Depoe Bay Beacon, a semi-monthly newspaper published for many years on the central Oregon coast, and as production manager of the Printer's NW Trader, a monthly magazine that served the print industry.

His interest in print journalism began in his youth; his parents owned and operated Jiffy Print in Portland, which later became Praise Printing in a nod to the company's focus on printing for Christian schools, colleges and ministries — ministries that included CNNW. Hirsch began working in various capacities at Jiffy Print when he was just 14.

Fortmeyer is concluding 45 consecutive years of newspaper work throughout Oregon and Washington, including the past 27 and ½ years at Christian News Northwest. A 1977 communications graduate of Seattle Pacific University, where he edited the campus paper his senior year, he then spent 18 years as a reporter or editor for small dailies or weeklies in Ontario, Astoria and Portland in Oregon, and in Anacortes, Wash., before establishing CNNW.

"I can't quite believe the time has arrived, but after four and a half decades of headlines and deadlines, I am concluding what has been a fulfilling and challenging lifelong career," said Fortmeyer. "But without a doubt, my greatest fulfillment has been serving much of the Pacific Northwest since 1994 with a newspaper focusing on God's work in the region. I have been grateful for that privilege, and also for the countless

wonderful friends I have made doing this newspaper and who have prayerfully supported our efforts."

Fortmeyer said he is delighted Hirsch is taking the helm.

"Tim and his wife Vicky are dedicated followers of Christ and my wife Sandy and I have been very pleased to get to know them as we have prepared this past year for this transition. Tim is a talented, experienced newspaperman who knows the industry at its most impactful way — at the local, community level. I believe he will do a great job with CNNW."

"Using my God-given journalism talents in a Christian setting has long been my goal," Hirsch said. In fact, one day having the resources to shepherd a Christian publication was part of the long-range goal when I started the Sun nearly 15 years ago. I've been a reader of CNNW virtually since the beginning and consider it a blessing to be given a chance to share my passion for the Lord in this way. I hope to carry on the great work that John has carried in for such a long time, and look forward to working with the Pacific Northwest Christian community."

In his retirement, Fortmeyer and his wife look forward to spending much more time with extended family, including their nine grandchildren, as well as some travel and church and ministry involvement.

Christian News Northwest is a regional monthly available for free at about 1,900 locations throughout Portland, Salem, Eugene-Springfield, Bend, Vancouver and dozens of other communities throughout western and central Oregon and southwest Washington. It is also available by mail subscription for \$25 in the U.S., \$30 elsewhere.

Hirsch said although there will be some changes in the newspaper's format, there will be no change in CNNW's emphasis on local news tailored toward the evangelical Christian community.



From Rescue Mission of Salt Lake, Salt Lake City, Utah

Nicole's story



About a year ago, I had a mental breakdown that landed me in the hospital.

It was the culmination of three years of living on the streets, using drugs, and being abused. As the hospital staff treated my psychosis, I was as low as a person could be. Many of my teeth had fallen out from years of drug addiction and street life and I looked as bad on the outside as I felt on the inside.

After three days, the hospital released me with a taxi voucher. I don't recall much, just getting into the cab, which eventually dropped me off at the Rescue Mission's Women's Center. I had never been there before, but I knocked on the front door.

They took me in and admitted me to the New Life Recovery Program. I truly believe it was God's hand that caused that taxi driver to drop me off at the Rescue Mission. It couldn't have been a random coincidence.

At the Rescue Mission I was welcomed into a loving home. Everything was provided for me and the people there related to me and seemed to genuinely care. At the time, I knew nothing about God. I had never been to church before. This was the first place I had ever heard about a loving, caring God.

Finding a place that teaches the truth about God in a loving way, especially when you are super broken, is an experience that is almost impossible for me to explain. I now know that Jesus graciously died for all my sins and that by believing in Him, I can be forgiven and have new life on this Earth and be welcomed into Heaven one day.

God has healed me in so many ways as I have gained a relationship with him and worked through recovery meetings and counseling.

When I was 14, I was diagnosed with a significant mental illness that was treated by medication. Throughout my life I have struggled with the illness, even being institutionalized on a couple of occasions.

Today, for the first time in my life since I was 14, I do not take one drug for mental illness and have no symptoms requiring medication. I believe that God has healed me.

God also generously provided me with free dentures. There are a couple of nonprofits the Rescue Mission works with that help provide dentures to formerly homeless men and women who have lost their teeth due to street living. Now, I have a great smile that almost gives me a new identity.

Having dentures gave me confidence when I entered the employment phase of the New Life Program. I had a few interviews for jobs that I didn't get, which was discouraging, but I was trusting that God would provide.

One day I was taking the TRAX train to Draper

where I had an interview. I started praying that God would lead me to the job He wanted for me. When I looked out through the train window I saw a van for a local plumbing and HVAC company. I took note that it was the first thing I saw after my prayer.

When I got home, I looked the company up online and called to ask if they were hiring. They said they were and about a month ago they hired me. I do scheduling and customer service, and even though I have only worked there a month, am now training new people.

Another way God has provided for me is through my home church, Capital Church. I love the people, and the signing, and the Bible teaching. One of our pastors recently lost a family member to COVID and it was amazing to see how his family trusted and stayed close to God through that difficult experience. It gave me courage that I could go through hard things in life and still trust God.

I am currently saving up money so that when I graduate from the New Life Program I can move into the Hope House, the Rescue Mission's transitional housing unit for women. There I will pay rent and have more freedom as I continue to take steps towards getting back to "normal" life.

One thing I would appreciate your prayers for is my son. I have a seven-year-old boy who lives with my mom back in rural Nevada, where I am from.

My mom has had legal guardianship over my son ever since he was little and my son believes that my mother is his mom. My mother has told me that my son does not know that I exist. I believe that my mother wants to continue acting as his mother, perhaps for his whole life.

I would like to be part of my son's life, but it is a difficult situation and it's hard to know what to do or how I should try to have a relationship with him and my mom. So please pray that God would open doors and bring healing and clarity to my family relationships.

I know the biggest thing for me is making sure I am on the right track to stay sober for my life. As I anticipate moving into Hope House, my goals are to maintain good employment and stay connected to my recovery community.

Additionally, I look forward to having good, clean sober fun! I want to go to a concert. I have never taken a vacation so I would love to do that as well. I am also trying to save up money for a car, once I get my Utah's driver's license.

When I came to the Rescue Mission I had nothing. No birth certificate, no social security card, no ID, not one piece of identifying information. I couldn't even prove who I was. It was as if I was nobody. The Rescue Mission graciously worked with me to get all those documents back so I could be a functioning member of society and have an identity again, including a true identity in Christ.

Thank you so much for supporting the Rescue Mission. I needed a place where I could learn about God and experience His life-changing grace and love. Your support has helped change and save my life and I am forever grateful!

Allison's story

Not long after she was married, Allison learned the husband she'd met online – and grown to love deeply – wasn't the man she believed him to be.

"He turned controlling and abusive, mentally, physically, emotionally," she explains. He took away her cell phone... isolated her from loved ones... and



repeatedly threatened to kill her.

Finally, in a crime too horrific for words, he took her mother's life and forced Allison to flee with him. The couple was apprehended and held in jail. Although Allison was innocent, it was the situation she needed to be freed from her captor. When authorities released her, she came to our doors, grief-stricken, traumatized and longing to build a new life.

"I would do anything to have her back with me, but I know she's with the Lord and she's happy. She was a very godly woman."

As Allison regains her confidence and peace of mind, she feels God calling her to help other women who have experienced abusive relationships. "I want to share my story to inspire them if they feel lost or hopeless. God is there for them and they will prosper from a relationship with Him. That's what happened to me."

While the holidays are difficult without her mother by her side, Allison is so grateful to you for the wonderful gift of a new life. "I'm very blessed and thankful because I have her spirit in me and I know God has a plan for me."

A pro-Israel advocate sees “haunting parallels” in Germany between the current COVID-19 crisis and the 1930s.

One of the ways Germans who refuse to take the mandated inoculations are being ostracized is that yellow painted signs reading, “DO NOT BUY FROM UNVAXXED” have appeared on store windows in the Central European country. “I’ve said for almost a year



that there are some haunting parallels between the 1930s and the 21st century here with this COVID crisis,” comments Jan Markell, founder and director of Olive Tree Ministries. “A new group of people in the 21st century are becoming the new untouchables, the new yellow-starred people. And that’s those who

just choose for various reasons, and there are lots of reasons, to be unvaccinated for COVID.”

She confesses that she never thought she would see in her lifetime any sort of resurgence of what happened in the ‘30s, and she believes the whole pandemic fits into end times prophecy.

“Someday the unsaved left behind after the rapture are going to be depending on the Antichrist, and what I see is a conditioning right now for prepping people to trust the government with their major decisions,” Markell submits. “Right now that’s health and are they going to keep their jobs, but they have to comply in order to please the government.”

Markell says she is “shocked” at the thought of how many people are going to be truly left behind to go through the tribulation.

High Court to Consider Taking Another ‘Jack Phillips’-type Case



A Colorado web designer and her legal team are hopeful the U.S. Supreme Court decides to hear her case as she fights to defend the constitutional right to express her religious beliefs in the products she creates.

Lorie Smith is a website designer in Colorado, where state law prohibits her from being able to express custom website messages that would be supportive of her religious view on marriage between a man and a woman.

Kristen Waggoner is an attorney with Alliance Defending Freedom (ADF), the law firm representing Smith. Waggoner explains that Smith basically is facing the same type of penalties that cake artist Jack Phillips is facing in Colorado.

“The issue in Lorie’s case is whether artists and Americans have the right to be able to create custom art and expression that is consistent with their conviction,” the attorney shares, “or whether the government can compel them to say things that they don’t believe or silence them from saying things that they do believe.”




The case has been getting extra attention in recent days, following a settlement agreement last week that ended a 2013 lawsuit brought by the ACLU against Washington state floral artist Barronelle Stutzman. ADF also handled that case.

“That settlement does not include a

change of Barronelle’s beliefs, it does not include a submission of her beliefs to the government or to the ACLU, and she has never once had to violate her conscience,” Waggoner shares.

“But at 77 she is going to retire and give her business to her employees – and she’s passing her legal torch on to Lorie Smith at 303 Creative.”

Smith’s case (303 Creative v. Elenis) could be heard before the U.S. Supreme Court soon. The high court will conference the case in early January and decide whether to hear arguments. Sixteen states, 45 members of Congress, and numerous legal scholars, economists, publishers, and media groups have filed friend-of-the-court briefs in support of the web designer.


