'Roe' Goes Down As Life Lifted Up

'Roe' goes down as life lifted up

Reaction is pouring in following today's announcement by the U.S. Supreme Court overturning the decision almost 50 years ago that legalized abortion across the nation – and took the lives of an estimated 63.5 million unborn babies.

In a 6-3 decision, the Supreme Court has overturned the 1973 landmark case Roe v. Wade, opening the door for states to put a variety of abortions restrictions in place. The ruling – which came in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization – came more than a month after the stunning leak of a draft opinion by Justice Samuel Alito indicating the court was prepared to take



this momentous step.

Voting in the majority were Justices Samuel Alito, Clarence Thomas, Neil Gorsuch, Brett Kavanaugh, and Amy Coney Barrett. Chief Justice John Roberts filed a separate opinion, agreeing with the court's decision to uphold the Mississippi law but arguing that the court should not have decided the broader question of whether the Constitution protects abortion at all. The

court's three liberal justices -- Stephen Breyer, Sonia Sotomayor, and Elena Kagan -- filed a joint dissent.

Dobbs was a challenge to a Mississippi law, passed in 2018, that bans virtually all abortions after the 15th week of pregnancy. It had never gone into effect because lower courts blocked the state from enforcing the law. Today's decision reversed those rulings and upheld the Mississippi law.

The ruling in Dobbs also overturns another pro-abortion

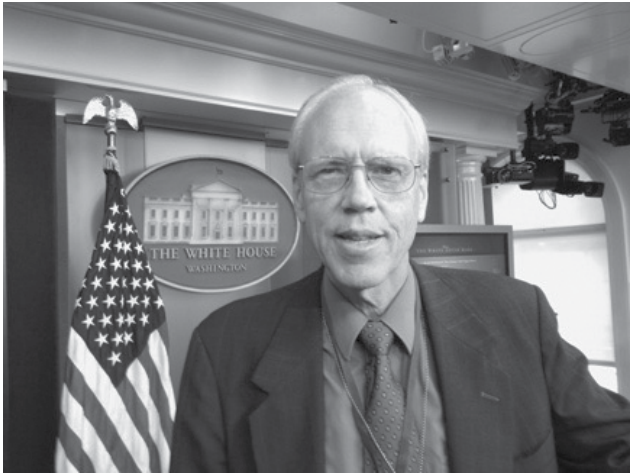

Christians United for Israel 2022 Washington DC National Summit

July 27, 2022

(POCATELLO, Id)—This year's summit was highlighted by some of the nation's most influential and prominent representatives from the United States congress, community leaders and supporters of Israel and the Jewish people. For me it proved to be one of the most inspirational, educational and motivating summits to this date.

A few of the highlights came from former UN Ambassador Nikki Haley, as she delivered a clear and unambiguous quote about what she thinks of any Iran deal signed by President Biden when she said from the stage, "No deal is better than a bad deal. And if this president signs any sort of deal, I'll make you a promise. The next president will shred it on her first day in office."

Haley's assessment of Biden's approach to Iran was



echoed by Senator Ted Cruz (R-TX) when he made it very clear to the Iranian officials that the deal signed by President Obama was not a legislative agreement made by the US congress. America has no obligation to Obama's agreement. Senator Cruz is leading the fight to stop Biden's effort for a new deal with Iran and to stop the Palestinian

consulate from being opened in Jerusalem. He also forced a vote to keep Iran on the list as a terrorist nation.

Senator Tom Cotten (R-AR) concisely summed up numerous elected officials' attitude towards Biden's dealings with Iran when he said, "Joe Biden is sitting down and negotiating with and trying to give away the farm to the ayatollahs." A host of speakers at the CUFI summit expressed strong concern about the current state

Church Recognizes Armed Vandal 'Has A Soul'

In the early hours of Saturday and Monday, security footage shows a gunman on a motorcycle fired bullets from a 9mm gun at the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Parish in Denver, causing about \$75,000 in damage.

"We immediately contacted the Arapahoe County Sheriff's Office on both occasions," reports Deacon Derrick Johnson, a spokesman for the church. "They came out, took pictures, took a report, and as far as we know, the investigation is still active. But we do not

know anything at this point on either of the incidents."

Though the motive is unknown, the incident comes at a time when American churches and pro-life organizations have experienced a growing wave of arson, vandalism, threats, and harassment since May, when a leaked U.S. Supreme Court opinion showed the justices were likely to overturn Roe v. Wade. LifeNews has documented more than 100 incidents since the leak.

The churches that have been vandalized do support life for the preborn, but as far as Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary is concerned, Johnson says another aspect of the case important.

"The person that did this has a soul, and we absolutely care about that soul and want them to come to know the person of Christ," Johnson tells AFN. "We will continue as a community to pray for them, to continue to pray for their conversion and for whatever is going on in their life, whatever hurt is in their heart. We definitely want the love of Christ and the grace of Christ to flow into that."

The church has a school on the property, and even though school had not yet convened for the school year at the time of the attack, security precautions have been taken.

From Rescue Mission of Salt Lake, Salt Lake City, Utah

Sarah's story



Note: Sarah Eliza first shared her life story in the August, 2020 Rescuer. Since then, she has had several struggles, but the spiritual grounding she experienced at the Rescue Mission led her back to the Mission when she needed help again. This is the story of how God worked in her life over the last two years.

I messed up after I graduated from the Rescue Mission in 2020. I'll share more about that later, but first I want to share about the catalyst God used to bring me back to the Rescue Mission to ask for help once again. It was my elementary-aged daughter who God used to put me back on track.

I had reunited with my husband. In the past we have had an abusive relationship, but I thought if I were sober, things would be better. They weren't. The abuse continued and our relationship turned even more toxic as my husband and I began using drugs together, living out of motels. We were unfaithful and my daughter went to live with my brother in the small-town of Henefer, Utah.

I saw her in October of 2020 and we talked about my relationship with my husband, who is not her father. She told me, "mom, you are not good for each other. I am never going to live with you as long as you two are together. I am not going to be in your life if you choose him, so choose him or choose me."

My daughter is nine years old but she could see what was happening to my life. She just had to work up the courage to speak the truth to me. My sister called me later and told me she talked with my daughter. My daughter told my sister that she regretted confronting me. She felt bad about it and wished she could take it back.

But I am so glad she did. I know the parent is supposed to take care of the child, but in that moment God reversed it, and the child took care of the parent.

I told my daughter she was absolutely right to say what she said, and I told her that I choose her. I knew she was never going to feel safe around my husband, who is in and out of prison. I had wanted to make our marriage work and know that God hates divorce, but I have Biblical grounds for divorce and am currently pursuing a divorce. My husband, from his prison cell, is fighting the divorce, so please pray that God would work it out. We have no property, no children, and no assets, so the only reason he is fighting the divorce is to keep control over me.

Nothing has come from our relationship but abuse, betrayal, addiction, and misery. I know God can restore all things, but I truly believe this

relationship needs to end. If God somehow restored our relationship later, it would be a true miracle. I want God's will to be done, so pray that He would do His will in this situation.

It was my relationship with my husband that caused me to come back to the Mission last December after initially graduating from the New Life Program in August, 2020. I did well for about a month after graduating but when I reunited with my husband, who also struggles with addiction, we devolved into a life of drug abuse, infidelity, and homelessness.

I was still working so we had money to live in and out of cheap hotels. But by April, 2021 my job performance (I processed rental applications for an apartment company) had declined so much that I was let go. Without much money and my husband in-and-out of prison for parole violations, my life turned to homelessness and hopelessness once again. It was at that point that I reached out to the Rescue Mission, asking for another chance.

The Mission took me back and helped me get back on track. They took me back based on real love that is dependent on God to make change in my life. They knew I had the tools I needed to stay sober and succeed, I had just abandoned them. With the Mission's help I was quickly able to return to God-enabled sobriety.

I connected with a good local church, New Creation Church in Sandy, and am encouraged by the people and teaching there. With a refocus on healthy relationships, counseling, Bible study, and prayer I have been able to stay sober for six months.

I secured a good job with Salt Lake County's Housing Connect program, which helps people secure vouchers for housing and get Section Eight housing opportunities. Currently, I am the case manager for over 300 individuals seeking housing through the Housing Connect program. It is a rewarding job as I know the realities of worrying about housing and fearing homelessness. By providing my clients with true housing opportunities that they can afford, I believe I am making a difference in their lives.

I am working on getting housing of my own and soon will have enough money saved to get into a place I can afford. I have enrolled my daughter in a charter school nearby my future apartment and hope she will be back living with me in August.

She has thrived in Henefer with my brother's family. She plays volleyball has a great friend in her cousin. I truly appreciate what my brother and his family have done to care for her. At the same time, I want my daughter and me to be a family again. Please pray that our reunion would be a smooth one. Pray that I would depend on God to keep me sober and employed and that God would help my daughter fit into her new school and situation. It is a big step for both of us, but as I told her back in October, "I choose you" and I have done everything possible to choose her ever since.

Thank you so much for supporting the Rescue Mission and giving me not only a first chance, but a second chance at redemption. Your support has meant everything to me and my family and I cannot thank you enough for how you have helped me.

"I go to recovery group and Bible Study. It's given me hope," she tells us. "This is my first time being in a close relationship with God. He came to me when I was down and didn't know my way. Ever since, I've



become closer to God. I've seen more opportunities for myself."

Looking ahead, Eileen plans to return to school and pursue a career in addiction counseling, with a focus on trauma and domestic

violence.

From personal experience, she knows the value of being in a caring environment and speaking with people who understand the challenges of addiction and homelessness. "At Montana Rescue Mission, they accept everyone for who they are," she says. "I'm very grateful for everything they've done for me."

Life Wins -- Supreme Court Overturns Roe v. Wade

WOODLAND PARK, Colo., June 24, 2022 / Christian Newswire/ -- After nearly 50 years and more than 60 million babies lost, Roe v Wade has been overturned by the U.S. Supreme Court.

In the Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization case, the Supreme Court sent the issue of abortion to the states to decide. In a majority decision, Justice Samuel Alito wrote, "The Constitution makes no reference to abortion, and no such right is implicitly protected by any constitutional provision."

Just last month, Alito's draft opinion leaked to the media, sending shockwaves through the nation—especially the pro-abortion camp.

According to Andrew Wommack, president of Truth & Liberty Coalition, "While this is a time of rejoicing and expressing our gratitude to the Lord for the brave men and women who made this decision, and all the people who have worked against abortion all these years, we also have to stand strong in the power of His might (Eph. 6:10)—because our work isn't done."

Dozens of states already have pro-life laws ready to enact in wake of Roe's reversal, but Colorado recently passed the most aggressive pro-abortion bill in the nation—allowing the murder of babies in the womb up to the moment of birth.

According to Richard Harris, executive director of Truth & Liberty Coalition, "This is an incredible and wonderful day in the history of America! In Isaiah 28, the prophet laments that Israel made a covenant with death but prophesies in verse 18 that God will disannul that covenant and bless the nation. Today, our national 'covenant with death' has been disannulled. Hundreds of thousands of innocent lives will now be spared in states with the moral clarity and courage to restrict abortion."

Standing for biblical truth, supporting pro-life legislation, and electing strong constitutional conservatives at the local, state, and federal level will be key in protecting the rights of the unborn and ensuring "life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness" for all Americans.

"Now that we are in the Third Great Awakening, we may see the end of abortion in this generation—but it will take the Church working together to see it come to pass," said Wommack.

The details in the Guidepost Solutions report are egregious and deeply disturbing. We are heartbroken for the victims of sexual abuse. There is no level of sexual abuse nor mistreatment of women, children, or men that is acceptable. In honor of the courage of the survivors who came forward to report abuse, and for the sake of righteousness in our denomination, the Utah-Idaho Southern Baptist Convention heartily affirms the recommendations of the Sexual Abuse Task Force Report.

In addition, we ask the messengers, churches, and those in leadership positions in the Executive Committee, the Utah-Idaho Southern Baptist Convention, and the Southern Baptist Convention to pray for God's wisdom, compassion, and strength to make the necessary changes to ensure the safety of all who attend our churches.

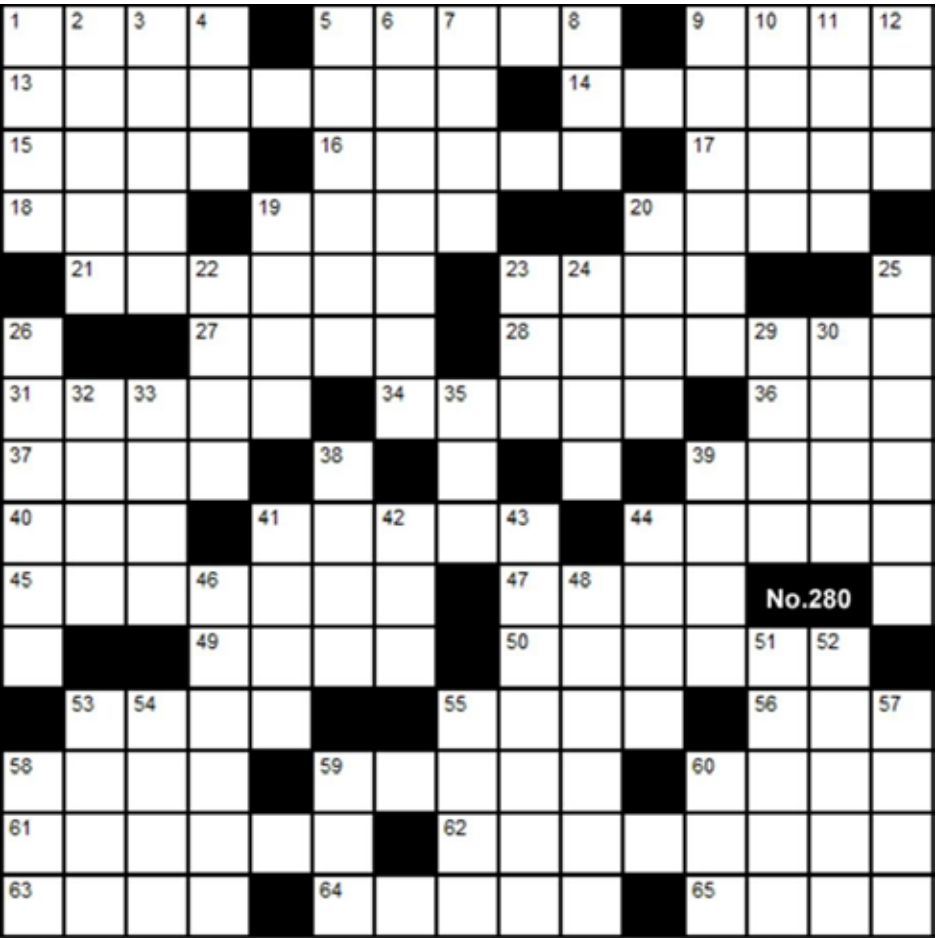

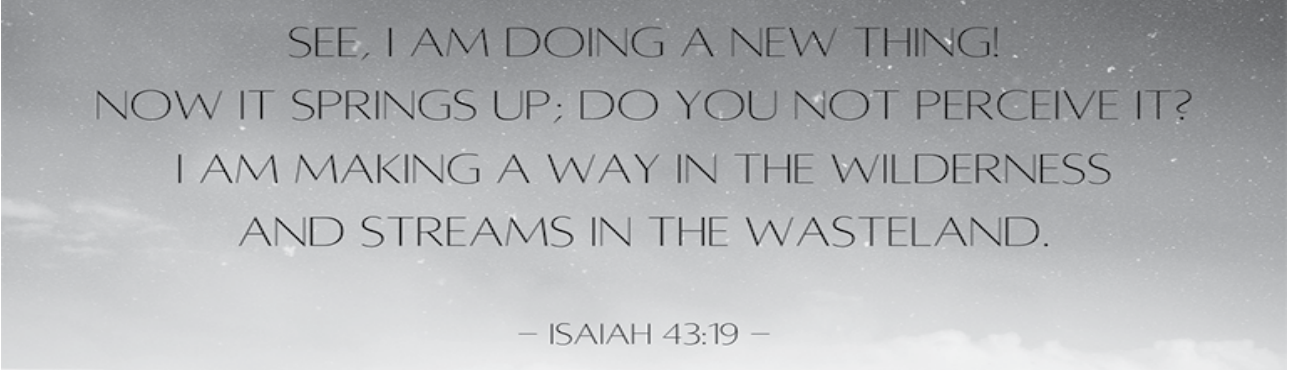

White House Correspondent's Protest Letter to Press Secretary

June 20, 2022

Dear Karine Jean-Pierre;

We once again respectfully request the Biden administration - without exception – re-open all of the traditional venues for presidential remarks at the White House, including the East Room and the South Court Auditorium, for any reporter admitted to the White House campus.

The current method of allowing a limited number of reporters into these events is not only restrictive and antithetical to the concept of a free press, but it has been done without any transparent process into how reporters are selected to cover these events. We are all left wondering who is making these decisions and what are the criteria on which they are based?

We appreciate that COVID-19 social distancing guidance played a role at first, but in the year and a half that Joe Biden has been president, and since such guidelines have been eased, we've never gotten an explanation as to why the areas that have traditionally been opened to all press remain restricted.

For any reporter not in the "pool" that covers the president, open press remarks represent the only time most of the reporters who cover the president might be positioned to ask him a question – or interact with him at all.

The continued inability of the White House to be candid and transparent about the selection process for reporters attending his remarks undermines President Biden's credibility when he says he is a defender of the First Amendment.

The incongruity of these restrictions underscores the belief by many reporters that the administration seeks to limit access to the president by anyone outside of the pool, or anyone who might ask a question the administration doesn't want to answer.

Let us be candid. Our job is not to be liked, nor is it to be concerned about whether or not you like what we ask. A reporter's ability to question the most powerful man in our government shouldn't be discretionary. The administration's continued efforts to limit access to the president cannot be defended. Any notion that space is "limited" is not supported by the fact that every other president before Biden (including Trump) allowed full access to the very same spaces without making us fill out a request form prior to admittance.

Thank you for your attention to these ahistorical problems. We ask you to see to it that the protocols are changed back to the access norms of which we are accustomed.

One Trump Hater Out in Wyoming, Second Hopes Alaska Ballot Saves Her

After her resounding defeat in a Republican primary, Trump-hating lawmaker Liz Cheney is being mocked for comparing herself to Abraham Lincoln and his famous history of suffering defeat at the ballot box.

After a 66%-29% loss to challenger Harriet Hageman, Cheney said in her concession speech “now the real work begins” because she is considering a White House run in 2024. She now has millions in campaign contributions, much of it from Democrats, to do that.

“The great and original champion of our party, Abraham Lincoln, was defeated in elections for



the Senate and the House before he won the most important election of all,” he said. “Lincoln ultimately prevailed.”

Gary Bauer of American Values says Cheney has the gall to quote the most famous Republican in history while she works alongside Democrats who are attacking our rights.

“The Democrat Party,” she says, “is attacking the First Amendment freedom of speech. It’s attacking the Second Amendment right to protect your family with a firearm. It’s attacking the right of assembly. It’s attacking religious liberty.”

On the Fox News program “The Five,” co-host Greg Gutfeld said he felt sorry for Cheney’s bizarre speech that tied her loss to the Civil War and to Union soldiers who fought in it.

“She is nuts, okay?” Gutfeld told his co-hosts. “She’s overtaken with such obsession, and such emotional bitterness, that she has this grandiose view of herself and it’s actually now getting embarrassing. It’s embarrassing for her.”

Alaska’s new ballot a ‘mess’

According to Bauer, the American public should be paying attention to two important national races in



Alaska, where liberal Republican Lisa Murkowski is attempting to keep her seat after voting to impeach Donald Trump.

On Tuesday, the incumbent senator advanced to the November election along with Trump-endorsed challenger Kelly Tshibaka and two other candidates.

“I think anybody that makes predictions about the mess in Alaska,” Bauer, referring to the controversial ranked-choice ballot, “will end up having egg on their face.”

Because of the new ballot, Alaskan voters will see four names vying for the state’s single U.S. Senate seat. Murkoski, 65, has held the seat since 2002 after her father, who was then U.S. senator, appointed her to his seat after Frank Murkowski was elected governor.

The ranked-choice ballot is new to Alaskans, who approved it in 2020 in a referendum called Ballot Measure 2. Voters narrowly approved it by 1%.

In a secretly recorded video, two of Sen. Murkoski’s campaign staffers have acknowledged they worked behind the scenes to approve Ballot Measure 2 knowing it would benefit their boss. The video was recorded by Project Veritas, the guerilla journalism group.

Sarah Palin, the former governor and former vice presidential candidate, will appear on the November ballot along with four others who are vying for Alaska’s sole U.S. House seat.

What breaks our hearts often leads us to act. John, and his wife Gloria, have been members of The Gideons for over 50 years. Their passion for helping people find Jesus Christ through the truth of Scripture has fueled some of their greatest moments in life and ministry.

A PARDON FOR THEIR SIN

In 1976, after hearing the testimony of Mary Kay Beard, God began leading Gloria toward jail ministry. She listened to some training from other Auxiliary and started preparing to go. "What pricked my heart about jail ministry was when I read verses about God cleansing us from all iniquity. I knew God could give these women a pardon for their sin. Even though they may have to remain behind prison bars, I wanted to tell them they could be forgiven," says Gloria.

She started training other Auxiliary in her camp and encouraging them to join her in jail ministry. Around that time, John came home from a Gideon prayer meeting and said, "Gloria, the Gideons have obtained permission for y'all to go to the parish jail." The door was open. Gloria was reminded of Isaiah 65:24, "Before they call I will answer; while they are yet speaking I will hear." And so, they started to go once a month to the parish jail in Shreveport, Louisiana, and God gave them excellent opportunities to share about Him.

"I knew God could give these women a pardon for their sin. Even though they may have to remain behind prison bars, I wanted to tell them they could be forgiven."

When John and Gloria moved to Texas in 1991, the Auxiliary told Gloria, "We're going to continue the jail ministry." They knew that was a concern of Gloria's—she didn't want to leave those women without having someone coming, sharing the Good News with them.

A CALL TO FAITHFULNESS

Jail ministry hasn't always been easy or fruitful for Gloria. "At times, I tell God, 'I quit...I'm not doing this anymore.' Then He reminds me He didn't call me to be successful but to be faithful and leave

the results to Him."

She will never forget meeting Ginger in a county jail. "As I talked with her, she told me she was a prostitute," says Gloria. "She didn't accept the Lord during that first visit. But as I would see her from time to time, she finally accepted Him as her Savior." She would get out of jail, and then she would get drawn back into the old lifestyle. "I can remember when she saw me pass by, she wanted to hide from me. And I said, 'Ginger, is that you?' She finally came to the bars to talk because she was so ashamed that she had fallen back into the old pattern of life."

Ginger was finally able to go to a Christian women's job corps where she was trained and doing well, she was giving her testimony at churches, and Gloria connected with her again. "She was living for the Lord! We brought her home, and she lived with us for a year. She was like a daughter to us but was drawn back into her old ways."

Throughout her years of ministering to women like Ginger, Gloria has seen many accept the Lord.



"Some of them do well, and then sometimes they do well for a time, but that's not my responsibility. Jesus commands us to go and tell. And that's what we must do."

I KNOW YOU!

In 2015, Gloria and some fellow Auxiliary were on a distribution at a rehabilitation facility. "When I walked in, I saw the name Vera printed on a lady's name tag. I recognized her because she had made a great impression on me when she was in the county jail." Gloria recalls her story:

I remember going up to the cell, and I asked the women, 'Do you know if you died tonight that you would go to Heaven?' Vera knew that she wouldn't but told me she would sure like to. The other women in the cell said the same thing and accepted the Lord that day. The following week, I was at another cell, and there was Vera. She began to tell the girls what had happened the week before. It seemed like every week that I went, Vera was in a different cell, and she was telling people about Jesus and how He had transformed her life. When she was sent to state jail, she asked me if I would pick up her clothes and belongings. For 14 years, I had a box in my storage room with Vera written on it.

Vera and Gloria had a joyful reunion that day at the rehabilitation facility. The administrator said, "We couldn't do without Vera around here." Vera replied, "I couldn't do without this place—it holds me accountable." God is effectively using her as she shares her testimony with others going through drug rehabilitation.

They are women who are broken and need to know Jesus. "They need help and love, which I like to give them," says Gloria. "Being an Auxiliary provides us with tools to use with these broken women. It also provides us with the confidence that we need as we approach them—it opens the door for us."

Planned Parenthood v. Casey – the 1992 decision that reaffirmed the right to abortion.

Former President Donald Trump, who appointed three of the justices who voted with the majority, praised the U.S. Supreme Court's decision in an interview with Fox News. He said the decision would "work out for everybody." He added that the decision is "following the Constitution, and giving rights back when they should have been given long ago," he said, according to the channel.

Associated Press says the ruling is expected to lead to abortion bans in roughly half the states. In anticipation of the decision, several states led by Democrats have taken steps to protect abortion access. The decision, AP adds, also sets up the potential for legal fights between the states over whether providers and those who help women obtain abortions can be sued or prosecuted.

Reaction

Dr. Alveda King (founder of Speak for Life): "For 49 years, 'we the people' have had to endure a flawed and unconstitutional ruling from the Supreme Court that allowed unelected judges to create a national right to abortion that ultimately led to extreme actions, like late-term abortions, against the unborn. Today, the Supreme Court has rightfully overturned that decision, sending the power to regulate abortion back to the elected officials at the state level. I have longed for and prayed for this day. And I will continue to fight for human dignity for everyone – from the womb to the tomb."

leaders across Texas. The vision was that students throughout Texas would follow these examples and meet at their school flagpoles to pray simultaneously. The challenge was named See You at the Pole™ at a brainstorming session during a meeting of key youth leaders. The vision was shared with 20,000 students in June 1990 at Reunion Arena in Dallas, Texas.

Only God had envisioned how many students would step up to the challenge. At 7:00 a.m. on September 12, 1990, more than 45,000 teenagers met at school flagpoles in four different states to pray before the start of school. Reports came into toll-free number for days after the first event.

A few months later, a group of youth ministers from all over the country gathered together for a national conference in Colorado. Many of them reported that their students had heard about the prayer movement in Texas and were equally burdened for their schools. No other events had been planned, but it was clear that students across the country would be creating their own national day of student prayer. There was no stopping them.

On September 11, 1991, at 7:00 a.m., an estimated one million students gathered at school flagpoles all over the country. From Boston, Massachusetts, to Los Angeles, California, from North Dakota to the tip of Texas, students came together to pray. Some sang, some read Scripture, but most importantly, they prayed. Like those first students, they prayed for their schools, for their friends, for their leaders, and for their country.

As in all great movements of prayer, See You at the Pole™ did not begin in the hearts of people. It began in the heart of God. God used the obedience of a small group of teenagers to ignite what has become an international movement of prayer among young

people.

Since 1991, See You at the Pole™ has grown to God-sized proportions. Within the first few years, the movement began to spread to other nations through missionaries from the U.S. Now each year, an estimated 1 million students from all the world participate in See You at the Pole™. Students in more than 64 countries have participated. In places like Canada, Korea, Japan, Turkey, and the Ivory Coast, students are responding to God and taking seriously the challenge to pray.

God is continuing to call His people to repentance and prayer. Countless inspiring testimonies of how He has used See You at the Pole™ to bring students to Christ and to change lives affirm God's power to answer those who cry out to Him in humble dependence. Bible clubs, weekly prayer meetings, and other ministries have begun on campuses where students participated in See You at the Pole™.

the first Christian churches. In 1 Timothy, he wrote, "The elders who direct the affairs of the church well are worthy of double honor, especially those whose work is preaching and teaching" (1 Tim. 5:17). And, in 1 Thessalonians, he said, "Respect those who work hard among you, who are over you in the Lord and who admonish you. Hold them in the highest regard in love because of their work" (1 Thess. 5:12-13).

Accordingly, over the centuries, decades and years, pastors have been recognized and honored, either formally or informally, by many denominations and local churches at various times of the year. It has been a long-standing practice.

Focus on the Family named and began emphasizing Clergy Appreciation Month in 1994, reminding congregations that it was biblical and proper to honor their pastoral staffs and pastoral families throughout the year, but suggesting that they set aside the month of October for a special tangible tribute. For those churches that preferred a single weekend, we recommended the second weekend of the month. However, honoring a church's entire

pastoral staff and their families can be done at any time — and, in fact, should become a normal part of a church's ongoing care of these special families throughout the entire year.

Our goal is that every pastor (including staff ministers) and his or her family would feel appreciated by those they serve. To assist congregations in this process, we have developed a planning guide (in both English and Spanish) intended to facilitate and publicize a CAM celebration. We also attempt to promote the concept ourselves each year through radio, newspapers, magazines and any other means at our disposal.

Over the years, we have been privileged to work in partnership with many publishers, bookstore chains, radio networks, news syndicates, musicians, denominations and other church groups, and have made many friends. Many of these fine organizations promote some form of clergy appreciation on their own. We think this is great! We feel that the fact that no one "owns" the idea of honoring pastors gives the campaign special inertia of its own — or from God.

of Iran’s nuclear program and the associated U.S. policy. These concerns were amplified last week when the head of the International Atomic Energy Agency, not known for always having the courage to speak bluntly – said that Iran’s nuclear program was “galloping ahead,” and his agency really doesn’t know much about what Iran is doing.

Unfortunately, Victoria Nuland, the Biden administration’s undersecretary of state for political affairs, isn’t listening. During a recent interview with CNN, Nuland said, “The deal is sitting there on the table for the taking, if the Iranian’s want it.” Surprise, they don’t want a deal. They want to drag out negotiations until they’ve achieved their nuclear ambitions.

One of the most memorable panels during the summit came when Senators Jacky Rosen (D-NY) and James Lankford (R-OK) joined CUFI Action Chairwomen Sandra Parker on stage for a discussion about anti-Semitism. The two Senators are the co-chairs of the Senate Bipartisan Task Force for Combating Anti-Semitism, and they delivered a powerful and united message on the importance of combating the world’s oldest hatred.

Ambassador David Freedman (U.S. Ambassador to Israel) delivered an inspiring message; how on May 14, 2018, 70 years to the day of Israel’s founding as a nation, Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu announced the opening of the United States Embassy in Jerusalem,

the eternal capital of the state of Israel. Isaiah 2: 3-4 says, “Many people will come and say, ‘Come, let us go up to the mountain of the Lord, to the temple of the God of Jacob. He will teach us is ways, so that we may walk in His path.’ The law will go out of Zion, the word of the Lord from Jerusalem.”

On Tuesday, we descended on our nation’s capital to meet up with 89% of the nation’s legislators to discuss and encourage support for three Pro-Israel pieces of legislation:

The House and Senate State-Foreign Operations Appropriations Bills, providing funding in American military assistance to Israel as outlined by the 2016 Memorandum of Understanding between the U.S. and Israel.

The Defend Act. The Abraham Accords, S.4366 H.R.7987. The Abraham Accords which were signed on September 15, 2020, brought forward normalization agreements between Israel and several Arab and North African states. The agreement not only enhanced Israel’s security but created an opportunity for a regional approach to critical security threats – chief among them, Iran’s malign activities across the Middle East.

COI Elimination Act, S. 4389 H.R. 7223 Restricts American taxpayers’ dollars from funding UNHRC’s anti-Israel Commission. The funds would be withheld until the U.S. Secretary of State certifies that the UNHRC has abolished its Commission of Inquiry (COI)

into Israel. The summit overall was a great success, providing ample inspiration and enthusiasm to continue the ongoing fight against anti-Semitism in our communities, colleges and universities campuses. The evidence shows that anti-Semitism has increased to levels never before seen. According to the annual Anti-Semitism Report published by the World Zionist Organization and The Jewish Agency. Christians United for Israel is dedicated to fighting against anti-Semitism wherever it may be found.

We are fortunate we live in a community where people live together in harmony, but the need is ongoing to educate to the facts concerning Israel and the Jewish people. The internet is a riff with anti-Zionism and anti-Israel propaganda, speaking out outrageous lies and misinformation to slander the only Jewish nation


