

**Prophecies About God Becoming a Man of Flesh
(That All Jews and All Christians Should Know)
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DIVINITY OF JESUS MESSIAH

A.) Promise of a PEACEMAKER

- I. [Genesis 3:15](#) “First promise of a savior”
- II. [Genesis 49:10](#) a.) “Scepter” means--- “kings”
b.) “Rulers Staff” means--“law”
c.) “Shiloh” means---“peacemaker”

The Kings of Judah will cease to exist and the law will be changed when the Peacemaker arrives.

The Last King of Judah was Zedekiah 597-586 B.C. The Babylonian captivity took place ca 586-539 B.C.

B.) Promise of the STAR

- I.) [Numbers 24:16-24](#) Vision of the Messiah
- a.) Ruler is one in a distance not near
 - b.) He is likened to a “star” v.17 Bethlehem’s star was this sign and fulfilled Balaam’s prophecy.
 - c.) He is called “scepter” and will crush Edom and Moab.
70 AD Edomites disappear from history
 - d.) Amelek—was the first nation to attack Israel after the Exodus.
King Hezekiah delivered death to Amelek (I Chron.4:39-43)
 - e.) Assyrian Captivity v.22
 - f.) “*Alas*” Demise of Mesopotamian powers “Kittim is Cyprus”
Alexander the Great—they will perish forever. Around 63AD Roman armies appeared and fulfilled that the Star and Scepter Appeared in history.

C.) NAME

- I.) “YHWH”: Divine Tetragrammaton Hebrew language lacked vowels

German influence: Y became a “J” and the “W” became a “V”
YHWH became a hybrid: Yehowah—or—Jehovah” The vowels came from the Greek word Adonai.

In the King James Bible: Lord- means owner

LORD -- means I AM or YHWH

God-- means Elohim or creator or strong one.

“I AM” comes from **Exodus 3:14**

LORD –Means “I AM”

Iasous (Greek) means I AM SALVATION

Iasous to Hebrew means “Yeshua”

Iasous to English means “Jesus”

Iasous to German means “Joshua”

Isaiah 43:1 “ see the clever usage of—“Lord, LORD.GOD” The question arises who is going to be the savior of the world?---Who does the Bible say it will be in Isaiah 43?

II.) **John 8:58**-This scripture clearly means Jesus is claiming to be the“**I AM**”

III.) **Matthew 1:23** “ Immanuel” means---“God with us.”

This says clearly God becomes a man of flesh.

Phyllis Diller the comedian once said, “Salvation cannot be brought down to one’s man name.” She did not believe Peter:**Acts 4:12** (read it)

John 1:14 “Word became flesh”---refers to **Genesis 1:ff**

John 1:18---Who was in the Garden of Eden that could be seen?

D.) FORM OF GOD

Since God became flesh He now has a form which some people call “the accommodated form of God.” In-other-words men are able to see God just as Adam and Eve saw God.

a.) **Colossians 1:15**

b.) **Isaiah 43:10** God has “one form.”

c.) **Isaiah 43:11** “Apart from me there no savior....”

E.) ONE ROCK AND ONLY ONE ROCK

a.) **Isaiah 44:8** only one rock

b.) **Daniel 2: 32-44** Stone (rock) smashed statue to dust and began an indestructible Kingdom.

c.) **Matthew 16:13-18**The big question is“**Who do people say that the son of man is?**”
WHO IS JESUS?

1.) Peter had two names: Cephas and Peter. PETER is “Masculine” in gender and

means: “a small stone.”

Do not forget the main question: Who do people say that Jesus is? *****

Answer: vs. 18 “...and upon this rock I will build my church...”**“Rock” used in this verse is used in the “Feminine” gender and not referring to Peter (masculine) but to a huge boulder and not a stone. Jesus was referring to Peter’s words of faith and not to Peter himself. It was Peter’s confession of faith and belief in Jesus as the Messiah and as God in the flesh—this is how God will build His church. Not on a begotten man but on a divine man ---Jesus. Jesus has several names. Now Peter has several names.---It was a play on words. When Peter said Jesus was the Messiah, his mind went back to the Old Testament regarding all the prophecies referring to him as Messiah, Savior, King, Star,---- Balaam’s, Moses’, words about Him....**

F.) VEIL

[Philippians 2:68](#) Some people do not have the ability to understand how God became a man and Jesus was that man—It is very difficult for some people to know this.

[II Corinthians 3:12-18](#) Paul here is saying that not only is Jesus God but He is also the Holy Spirit. How easy is that for some people to grasp?

G.) WORD

I.) [John 1:1](#) **“Word was God” not, “a God” but The God.**

Colwell’s law in Greek says it is proper to interpret this as “the God.”

II.) [John 1:17](#)

[John 3:16](#)

In these two verses the Greek word “monogena” has one “n” and not two “n’s” It Is not---“monogenna” it is “monogena”

a.) monogenna--- means begotten of normal birth

b.) monogena---means “one genus” This means Jesus is the only one literally of God. He is the only man directly from God. His genus is directly of and from God. He was born of a virgin without a human sperm. Joseph was not the father or sire of Jesus but His guardian. This is why the genealogy in Matthew and Luke reveal the grandfather not impregnating his wife (he died) and his brother impregnated his wife for him. The same applies to the father of Jesus. Joseph was not the real father but it was God. That is why different names are recorded for the grandfather in Matthew and Luke. God is the real Father of Jesus not Joseph---monogena!

H.) WILL (Old Will and New Will) Sometimes referred to as Old Testament, Old Promise, Old Covenant and New Testament, New Promise, New Covenant.

I.) [jeremiah 31:31](#) New Promise is coming

- a.) In order to write a will one must own the property and be the author.
- b.) To put a will into effect the author must die.

Jesus died to activate the new promise. He had to be God to be able to make it legal. Jesus was the God and not a God!

- c.) [Hebrews 9](#)

II.) The countdown to activating the will was provided in Daniels prophecy of the 70 weeks.

A.). [Daniel 9:24](#). Only 6 things were covered by this scripture:

- 1. Finish the transgression**
- 2. Make and end of sin**
- 3. Make atonement for iniquity**
- 4. Bring in everlasting righteousness**
- 5. Seal up vision**
- 6. Anoint the most holy place (baptism of Jesus)**

There are only two men referred to next: Jesus the prince or king and the Romans.

a.) Vs.27 The person that puts an end to sacrifice and brings in a new covenant is Jesus. His death on the “cross” enabled the above 6 things possible. Jesus is not an antichrist. The people that say this do not understand prophecy. Jesus puts an end to sin and the Romans (Titus & Domitian) put an end to the Temple in Jerusalem --- ending Judaism. Now becomes the age of Christianity. The body is the new temple. Get this right and many other things that the apostles wrote about make more sense.

If the churches had interpreted this piece of Daniel correctly more Jews would have accepted Jesus as the Messiah. Instead some churches made the prince the antichrist and ruined the proper meaning of the scripture. Thus Jews and Christians alike are confused about the countdown to the cross and the end of sin.

I.) JESUS IS KING

I.) [I Timothy 6:12-16](#) Talks about God being invisible yet the subject is Jesus. Paul here is saying Jesus is King and God.

II.) [See John 18:34ff--John 1:18](#) The Kingdom belongs to Jesus, He is God in the flesh. It is His Kingdom. The cross had it written in three languages: “King of the Jews**”**

III.) [Matthew 17:2](#) - Mt. of Transfiguration.
