OBITUARY: Luis Palau 1934-2021


(PORTLAND, OR) March 11, 2021-After a three-year battle with stage IV lung cancer, evangelist Luis Palau died today at his home in Portland, Oregon. He was 86 years old.

For more than 65 years Palau played an influential role in Christian missions and worldwide evangelism as a powerful speaker, teacher, and author. His work took him to more than 80 nations and his campaigns allowed him to present a clear case for Christianity to an audience of more than 1 billion people through television, radio, print, and live events.

Standing strong for issues of faith and the importance of a vibrant, healthy spiritual life according to the teachings of the Bible, Palau was well regarded by leaders around the globe, including presidents, nobility, business leaders, and church clergy.

Originally from Argentina, Palau was

born on November 27, 1934, in Ingeniero Maschwitz, a small town outside Argentina's capital of Buenos Aires. He became a follower of Jesus Christ at the age of 12, just two years after his father's untimely death. Palau began preaching on street corners as a teenager and hosting his own Christian radio program by the age of 19. He was invited to the United States in 1960 by Ray Stedman, a pastor and missionary leader from Palo Alto, California, who met Palau while in Argentina and

his own evangelistic organization in 1978. Throughout their lives Palau and Graham stayed close friends.

With a special heart for his home country of Argentina, and Latin America as a whole, much of Palau's work over the years focused on the Spanish-speaking world. His two daily radio programs in Spanish, Cruzada con Luis Palau and Luis Palau Responde, have aired in millions of homes for decades. He had Continued on Page 8

began mentoring him shortly thereafter. While studying at Multnomah School of the Bible (now Multnomah University) in Portland, Oregon, Luis met his wife, Patricia Scofield, and together they embarked on a life of missions - first going to Latin America and eventually to more than 80 nations around the world.

"I have no regret in pouring out my years, from the time I was a boy, for the sake of the Good News. If I was given a thousand lifetimes, I would dedicate them all to the same calling." - Luis Palau

Early on in ministry, Palau served as an intern with the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association, occasionally helping as the late Reverend Billy Graham's Spanish translator. Mr. Graham and his team played a significant role in opening doors of opportunity for Palau as he launched out with his own ministry efforts, and eventually helped him start



WASHINGTON, March 5, 2021 /Christian Newswire/ -- On Wednesday, March 3, 2021, American Christians Leaders for Israel (ACLI), representing hundreds of Christian leaders, sent a letter to President Biden proposing a number of guiding principles that ACLI sees as significant for his administration regarding the security of the United States, Israel, and the Jewish people.

The guiding principles include: not re-entering the Iran nuclear deal; requiring bilateral negotiations to resolve the Palestinian-Israeli conflict; honoring the Abraham Accords; adopting the International Holocaust Remembrance Alliance (IHRA) definition of anti-Semitism across all Executive Branch agencies; and, committing to work to combat anti-Semitism at all governmental levels here and aboard, in particular to oppose the boycott, divestment and sanctions movement (BDS).

Dr. Susan Michael, Director, ICEJ USA & ACLI commented, "ACLI is deeply concerned with the rising incidents of anti-Semitism in the United States and around the world. We want to ensure this administration works to combat this evil and also keep the United States' relationship with Israel strong."

Anthony Harper note: This following journalist complaint letter about restricted White House press access is addressed to the current White House Press Secretary Jennifer Psaki written by White House journalist Brian Karem that I and other news reporters are co-signers on.



WHCA as a gatekeeper. The White House has delegated to the WHCA the responsibility for determining which journalists can access the White House on a daily basis. The WHCA is conducting a lottery to distribute access to the COVID tests you now demand in order to work on the White House campus. As you know, the WHCA is made up of White House correspondents - journalists who cover the White House and the government generally. Journalists should never act as government agents - deciding who actually has access to the White House complex and when. The Secret Service does this quite well and there have been several court cases that address this issue. Moreover, it would be a mistake to think that the WHCA speaks for all journalists or even all White House correspondents. Further, the idea of allowing just 80 reporters into the complex seems arbitrary. While I have no reason to doubt what you told me, that the number was reached by talking to experts, that doesn't really answer the question. An email from the WHCA says "Press access on the White House complex is limited to

"Dear Jen;

I'd like to address your new press policy regarding access to the White House and particularly in the briefing room.

The new policy solves a problem that doesn't actually exist. Not one reporter in the White House has transmitted the coronavirus to another in a year. Overall the infection rate has been minimized because we've policed ourselves very well. Some of us, like myself, pay for our own testing. We wear masks and socially distance. The problem, prior to this administration's arrival was in the White House staff. They never wore masks or bothered socially distancing and as a result they got sick. Even then, the press rarely did - though we were in close proximity.

I am also concerned about the decision to use the

Session Delayed!

The big news today is that the Legislature has recessed until April 6 in response to a number of reported COVID cases among legislators and staff. This means another two and half weeks (at least) before the Legislature will take up proposals for tax relief, education reform, and efforts to constrain executive emergency powers. Wouldn't it have been better to accomplish these goals over the last ten weeks instead of putting them off until (what was supposed to be) the very last week of the session?

Defending the Second Amendment

It was wonderful meeting with enthusiastic patriots Friday morning who are passionate about protecting our right to keep and bear arms. They were at the Capitol to express their support for House Bill 300, the Small Arms Protection Act, sponsored by Sen. Christy Zito. This legislation is designed to protect the rights of Idahoans from the regulation and registration schemes (and eventual confiscation) that are already moving forward in Washington, D.C. There is another proposal in congress to ban hundreds of firearms, including all modern sporting rifles. We can't waste any time in fighting back and doing whatever is necessary to protect and preserve our rights.

Unfortunately, this important piece of legislation has been languishing because certain committee chairs have been refusing to give it a hearing. I hope these



issues can be resolved during this recess, so Idahoans can get the public hearing for the bill that they deserve. **Remembering the Fallen**

On Sunday, I had the honor of attending a Celebration of Life for Idaho's fallen soldiers Chief Warrant Officer 4 Jesse Anderson, Chief Warrant Officer 3 George "Geoff" Laubhan, and Chief Warrant Officer 3 Matthew Peltzer, all who lost their lives in a tragic training exercise last month. Over 200 riders participated in the event, which raised more than \$30,000 to support the families.

A big thank you to all who helped make this event so successful! Jesse, Geoff, and Matt you will never be forgotten!

Denomination's 'Steep Decline' Goads This So. Baptist Leader

The executive director of the Northwest Baptist Convention has been nominated to lead the entire Southern Baptist Convention (SBC). In this second profile of candidates for the presidency of the SBC, One News Now caught up with Randy Adams.



Randy Adams (pictured) is father to two grown sons. He grew up in Montana and in his current position serves about 500 churches and church plants in Oregon, Washington, and northern Idaho. What is a Western boy doing vying to be president of the Southern Baptist Convention?

"We actually have more churches than any other Protestant group, certainly, in the Northwest," he replies. "We began in 1948 in the Northwest with 15 churches. Now we have about 500 – and almost about a third of our churches worship in a language other than English."

Adams graduated from Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Ft. Worth. He shares that he has great concerns about where the SBC has been going the last decade. He describes the denomination as "in steep decline."

"I believe, personally, we need more transparency in our finances in our Southern Baptist entities, and more accountability in our finances as well – and not just in finances, but also performance," he explains.

One News Now asked Adams his thoughts on Critical Race Theory and Intersectionality as it pertains specifically to Resolution 9 passed by the denomination in 2019.

"The Bible doesn't define people according to their identity – [their] immutable characteristics, for example," he responds. "So, any theory that would place a person in a group according to [their] immutable characteristics ... I think is dangerous."

When asked about the controversy over Russell Moore and the Ethics & Religious Liberty Commission, he says church leaders shouldn't endorse candidates. But his biggest beef with the ERLC is an amicus brief the Commission filed in a lawsuit involving the SBC. He says it wrongly argued that the SBC is a hierarchy- when, in fact, Southern Baptist churches are autonomous.

"To me, that is the biggest and most egregious mistake the ERLC has made, maybe in its entire history - [and] certainly in the last year," Adams concludes.

The denomination meets in Nashville June 15-16, during which SBC messengers will elect its next president.

Suddenly, you are transported into a foreign culture - foreign to every good thing you have been taught. Women line the streets with apparent emotional detachment. Throngs of men, young and old, walk side by side - groups of young men laughing, older men walking with purpose. There is no alluring of the men necessary. The men are there for sex. The women are there to provide it.


These women and children are real, living, breathing human beings. But their bodies have been devalued in the eyes of man - reduced to a short term, physical purpose with seconds of pleasure. Seconds of pleasure compared to the life of a young human being, made in the image of God. It is not surprising that a woman would devalue herself when treated like an object with no worth.

These ladies are rejected as the worst of society. Doctors do not want to touch them or pay attention to their physical complaints, so they frequently misdiagnose and mistreat them.

Even Non governmental Organizations (NGOs) take advantage of them with photo shoots of spending a few minutes with them bringing in thousands of dollars for other causes within their organizations.


There is, however, one NGO committed to truly serve the ladies and the children of the RLD. This organization is Christian and led by Suzie and her husband Jo. For their protection, I shall refer to this NGO as AT, and the real names of the leaders have been changed. They partner with Vision Beyond Borders (VBB). Suzie and her staff visit the area daily. She has opened a salon, which serves as the center of her ministry. Young girls are trained and hired to run the salon, which serves women from the RLD, charging only a minimal amount. They feed and teach children of the workers six days a week, displaying genuine love and caring, demonstrating God's love for them in the flesh."



Evans' story



It's midnight and Evans finds himself walking around, going no place in particular. Evans has no home to call his own-no support system to help him.

He lived at The Crossing when he was part of Denver Rescue Mission's New Life Program, a longterm rehabilitation program for men, but after using drugs, he had to leave the program.

Evans, a 23-year-old Mission guest now staying at the 48th Avenue Center, grew up in Kenya in a strict, Christian household. His family moved to Texas in 2009 when he was 12. Although his parents raised him to be Christian, Evans fell away from his faith around the age of 14.

For Evans, his addiction began with peer pressure. At the age of 16, he started smoking marijuana with friends, which led to struggles with drug addiction. After graduating high school and joining a fraternity in college, his addiction only became worse. "That's all they did, 24/7, is just drink. I could have said no, but," he said hesitating, "it's not as easy as it sounds."

Evans decided that it would be best to leave college and move to Denver to live with his parents. He thought living with family would help him overcome his drug addiction, but he continued to struggle. In December of 2019, Evans lost his home. With nowhere to go, he found the New Life Program at the Mission.

Months later, Evans found himself on the streets again. One night as he walked aimlessly, Evans questioned everything. Why had he gone out and used drugs when he was so close to finishing the program? While reflecting on his time in the program and the counseling he received, Evans knew he couldn't spend time with friends who peer pressured him into a destructive lifestyle any longer.

Now, Evans is working at the Women's Bean Project in Denver with plans to go back to school to study information technology. He is also lining up a place to live. Denver Rescue Mission gave him an opportunity to get back on track.

"When I started [at the Mission], I was not in the right state of mind," he said. "Ever since being [here], I'm ready to go back to work and actually function."

Evans continues to grow in his faith as he navigates pushing through difficult days. By keeping the word

Jeremy's story



At a very young age, Jeremy was hurt by an adult he looked up to and trusted. "And it really emptied my soul," he says. As he grew older, he tried filling the void with "every drug you can imagine." Instead it resulted in homelessness, incarceration and suicide attempts - years of self-destruction, suffering and sorrow.

"I remember walking the streets thinking, 'I don't want to live this way," he says.

Yet through it all, he sensed God's presence. And when a friend told him about Wyoming Rescue Mission and our Bible-based Discipleship Recovery Program, he felt the Lord guiding him to our doors.

Now in our care, "I'm being renewed by God's Word," he says. "I'm soaking up everything because

I've just been so empty."

As he strengthens his relationship with the Lord, he has forgiven the adult who betrayed him and is

healing from the wounds of the past. And inspired by our faith-filled teachers, he is embracing tools to build a godly life.

"I feel like I'm getting a doctorate in their classes because they're so filled with the Holy Spirit," he says. By their example, too, he has also found God's purpose for his future. He plans on continuing his education to become a substance abuse counselor. "I'm going to have a ministry in Jesus' name," he shares. "I know in my heart that's the only reason I'm still alive." Thanks to the blessing of your support, Jeremy is celebrating Easter as a new creation in Christ. "I've been such an empty vessel in the past that all I want is for Christ to fill me up so I can help somebody else. I'm very hopeful... very happy!"

Carmen Powers was born and raised Duluth, in Minnesota. She was the eldest of five children and attended a Catholic school for most of her early childhood. Her dad was an alpha male. Though a very

successful businessman, he always valued family life. He put God first, and he had a special gift of always fixing things. He often took Carmen and her siblings with him when he traveled. Each time they would stay in a hotel, she would check for a Bible in the drawersomething about it gave her comfort and assurance she was staying in a good place. When she married her high school sweetheart, Jon, her dad became a strong example of male leadership to him. Jon came from a broken family, and he admired Carmen's dad and looked to him for guidance in many ways.



Not long into their marriage, Carmen's father was diagnosed with cancer. The family knew he wouldn't make it, but when he passed away shortly after the birth of Jon and Carmen's first child, it hit them extremely hard. They grieved his death. Suddenly, the person they had always leaned on wasn't there anymore, and their lives became confusing. They struggled to maintain their finances. As they were trying to put together a plan, a friend came to them and offered them a deal. He told them they could make US\$100,000 by completing a one-time "transaction" for him. It sounded simple, until they were informed the transaction was selling cocaine. Jon and Carmen knew the offer was wrong, but it was too tempting to refuse. With that kind of money, they could build a house and start a savings account.

of God close, he knows he can endure anything.

"There [have been] many times that I wanted to say screw it and just go out and drink and do all sorts of drugs because I was at my lowest," he said. "But instead, I picked up the Bible and read a couple verses in Proverbs or Samuel, which pushed me through it."

Before Jon and Carmen knew it, one transaction turned to two and then to many more. Eventually, the product transactions turned to product using. They discovered it doesn't matter who you are or what you tell yourself, once you have that much cocaine in front of you, it becomes hard to resist. This behavior lasted for about three years. Jon and Carmen had two children, and she would use drugs at night when they were sleeping. They were profitable, but we were far from satisfied. They continued spending more than they were making. Now, they were again in financial trouble and also addicted to drugs.

Wanting to get out of the situation, Jon and Carmen visited a friend in Florida, hoping time away would help them get some clarity. During that time, and with her friend's help, Carmen decided she and the kids were going to move out of Minnesota, regardless

the opportunity to share the Good News of Jesus Christ personally with dozens of Latin presidents, dictators, and heads of state. He was regularly called upon by leaders and media alike to share words of wisdom and insight during times of crisis. And his Spanishspeaking festivals and gatherings



throughout the Latin world will forever be known as some of the largest, most historic of their kind.

Palau's heart for the world and passion for sharing the life-changing message of Jesus pushed him beyond Latin America as well. Over his decades of worldwide ministry, Palau and his team have held more than 500 evangelistic campaigns, festivals, and rallies in more than 80 nations, including historic campaigns in leading world cities such as New York City, Buenos Aires, London, Madrid, Singapore, Hong Kong, Cairo, and Mexico City.

During the '70s and '80s, Palau was one of the few foreign preachers allowed to hold spiritual campaigns within the old Soviet Union, and when the iron curtain came down in 1991, he was among the first to hold open-air stadium campaigns in the region. Similar campaigns in seemingly "closed" nations in the Middle East and Asia also helped break down barriers and set new standards for mass evangelistic efforts. As a result, the name Luis Palau is now synonymous with innovation, collaboration, and cutting-edge evangelistic models that challenge stereotypes and reach all levels of society.

In addition to citywide evangelistic festivals, Palau's worldwide ministry has grown to include three international daily radio programs in both Spanish


and English, reaching more than 48 nations; a Global Network of Evangelists, inspiring encouraging and thousands of evangelists around the world; a City Gospel Movements effort, focused on training and equipping city leaders to better engage with their community; extensive television outreaches; and a digital evangelism effort which reaches

millions of individuals each year through social media.

Through all these efforts, Palau and his team have partnered with tens of thousands of churches to lead millions of individuals in decisions to follow Jesus Christ.

As an author, Palau published dozens of books and booklets throughout his lifetime. Some of his most well-known books, including God is Relevant, ¿Con quién me casaré? (Whom Shall I Marry?), Where is God When Bad Things Happen?, and Say Yes!, have been translated into dozens of languages and distributed into the hundreds of thousands. His Bible commentary in Spanish is recognized as one of the best in the field. His Starting Point Study Bible (published with Zondervan) was a 2003 Gold Medallion finalist for best Bible of the year. His video courses in Spanish have helped train tens of thousands of pastors and church leaders. And more than 10 million copies of his most popular booklet, What is a Real Christian?, have been distributed in over 60 nations.

Palau was president of OC International (previously known as Overseas Crusades) in the late 1970s. He served on the boards of Gordon-Conwell Theological Seminary, Dallas Theological Seminary,



and Multnomah University. He also served as an elder in his home church of Cedar Mill Bible Church in Portland, Oregon, and has been the recipient of several honorary doctorates from institutions such as Wheaton University and Talbot School of Theology.

In 2019, Palau published Palau: A Life on Fire, a deeply spiritual and intimate biography tracing his faith journey from humble beginnings on the streets of Buenos Aires, Argentina, to sharing the Good News with millions around the world. In the same year a feature-length movie about his life was also released in theaters throughout North and South America.

For the past several years, Palau's sons have run the day-to-day operations of the ministry based in Portland, Oregon. Kevin Palau serves as the president and CEO. Keith serves on the Development team. And



Andrew, Palau's third son, has followed in his father's footsteps as a well-respected evangelist, leading similar evangelistic campaigns around the world. Stephen, Palau's youngest son, faithfully serves as an elementary school teacher in the Portland area.

Luis Palau is survived by his wife, Patricia; his sons Kevin, Keith, Andrew, and Stephen; his daughters-inlaw Michelle, Gloria, and Wendy; his sisters Matilde, Martha, Catalina, Margarita, and Ruth; his brother Jorge; 12 grandchildren; and many beloved extended family. A private memorial service will be held in Luis' hometown of Portland, Oregon, and will be livestreamed for the general public at www.luispalau. org. 





Just Days Before the Passing of Famed Evangelist Luis Palau, His Son Andrew Was Carrying on the Work with Festival in Florida

BREVARD COUNTY, Fla., March 22, 2021 / Christian Newswire/ -- With news of the passing of famed evangelist Luis Palau, some have wondered what will happen with the ongoing work of the Luis Palau Association. For more than ten years now, three of Luis Palau's sons--Andrew, Kevin, and Keith--have been leading the day-to-day operations and vision of the team. In fact, just days before Luis' passing, his son Andrew was in Florida, working with more than 200 churches on a citywide evangelistic festival that reached thousands of individuals with the Good News of Jesus Christ.

Andrew Palau, who was himself led to Christ through one of his father's campaigns in Kingston, Jamaica in 1993, has held the role of co-evangelist with Luis for the past 15 years. The two have often partnered together on citywide campaigns, including massive efforts in New York City, Grand Rapids, Alaska, Argentina, Chile, Spain, Vietnam, and beyond. Andrew has also led many of his own festivals, including historic efforts in Uganda, Jamaica, Burundi, Malawi, Haiti, Tanzania, Indonesia, Ethiopia, and Colombia. The two have shared the work of the team's extensive radio ministry, while Andrew and his wife, Wendy, have taken the lead role in Palau's digital evangelism efforts known as Hope with God.

Andrew's latest effort, March 6-7, was known as Space Coast CityFest. It brought together thousands of Christians from throughout Brevard County, Florida, and included several evangelistic outreaches in the region.

The campaign was originally scheduled for March 2020. But with Covid-19 hitting Florida just days before the festival, the local committee decided to push it to 2021. In the meantime, more churches joined the effort, more local believers were able to engage, and even more anticipation and excitement was built for the festival. Many of the leaders involved



David Garrison and Don McCurry -- focuses on Muslim refugee and immigrant communities in North America. It spotlights a different North American city each day, including:

Muslim immigrants living in Houston, Texas, who served as translators for the U.S. military in Afghanistan

Iranian Muslims living in Toronto, Canada, who listen to Christian broadcasts in their native Farsi language.

Job-seeking Muslim families who've flocked to North Carolina's Triangle region, where hundreds of Christians at 45 local churches pray for them.

The fast-growing Bangladeshi Muslim community in New York's Jackson Heights area -- previously a haven for Irish immigrants.

"In the U.S., many Muslims are as American as apple pie," Filidis said. "They serve in the American forces, provide vital services and also pursue the American dream."



80 members of the media at any one time." Is it 80 at a time or a day? Who is keeping track of people as they go in and out? This is a horrible position to put the WHCA board in as they all have regular jobs to do as well. It is also disconcerting to see members of the Board shuffling through the Brady Briefing room and the working office space acting like cops trying to enforce your standards. If you're going to test everyone, have 150 tests provided and ask reporters to act as responsibly as they have in the last year, and you will have few problems.

Crews rotate in and out. Some people come to the White House simply to shoot a standup, or to type up a story, or meet a source and then leave. The actual number who stay all day is nowhere near 80 these days. Again, we've effectively policed ourselves. There is no need for anyone to fix this. And, the idea of limiting people to standing outside for a good portion of the day - except to use the restroom facilities - is incompatible with the weather, human and professional needs. I'm sure you don't want people to gamble on getting pneumonia versus the covid virus.

I would also like guidance on when the restrictions will be lifted and what the specific criteria for that would be? Since we've never passed on an infection to another reporter, and our infection numbers have been far lower than the White House or the general public for that matter, it seems we've already met any reasonable expectation to handle ourselves professionally during a pandemic.

Personally, instead of saddling the WHCA with additional responsibilities for which they shouldn't and actually don't have authority, and which may include conflicts of interest and possible First Amendment violations, the White House should simply reconsider the policy or test more of us.

After all, on another point, the policy is a potential public relations nightmare. How good would it be to have a reporter videotape the moment when a member of the White House staff tries to roust them from the White House or denies them access even if they have a hard pass? It's not a good optic. As I said Wednesday, the press policy regarding access by the Trump administration was one of the few things Trump's team did that actually worked. The protective pool got tested. The rest of us came and went - wearing masks and limiting our time on campus as needed. On occasion the Trump administration opened up briefings to east room appearances or in the Rose Garden. On those occasions, the expanded venue allowed for additional seats which were provided to those reporters who weren't in the press pool.

For the last year the restricted pool and a select few others who the WHCA board approves, with no posted standards or method of determination, have been given various degrees of access to the briefing room and the president himself. Everyone else has been frozen out.

As a result people in our business face the very real possibility of losing their jobs if they lose access to the White House.

That's a fact. The best solution to this problem

churches of all denominations and all parts of our county came together. It speaks well for our future as the body of Christ in Brevard County."

In addition to the free, two-day festival at Space Coast Daily Park on Saturday and Sunday (March 6-7, 2021), there was a concerted effort to expand the reach of Space Coast CityFest through multiple affinity events and smaller outreaches. These events included prison outreaches (with the partnership of Prison Fellowship), an evangelistic luncheon for business leaders, a breakfast for first responders, and two gatherings for women led by Andrew's wife, Wendy.

All this was in the lead up to the 2-day festival at Space Coast Daily Park in Brevard County, Florida on March 6 and 7 featuring award-winning artists Casting Crowns, Zach Williams, Mandisa, Mac Powell, Andy Mineo, and Social Club Misfits. Andrew Palau shared a clear Gospel message each night and challenged those in the crowd--and the thousands who tuned in online--to give their life to Jesus Christ.

The 2-day festival also hosted a family fun stage, stunt demos from professional skaters and BMX athletes (in partnership with The Stunt Dudes), and multiple presentations of the Gospel.

In total, including all events, CityFest organizers estimate more than 14,000 people were reached in person through the week-long campaign, with tens of thousands more tuning in to the multiple live broadcasts.

"Space Coast CityFest was a monumental event for our community," said Brad Russell, lead pastor of The Grove Church in Titusville. "It brought unity to our churches and is helping change the spiritual atmosphere of our county."

The event marked 14 years since the Palau Association last came to Florida. The last campaign in 2007 in Orlando was led by Andrew's father, the late evangelist Luis Palau, and established many longterm relationships within the community.

Bishop Merton Clark, senior pastor of Truth Revealed Ministries International in Palmbay commented, "I've witnessed the gathering of church leaders, members, and marketplace leaders, coming together for the sole purpose of advancing the kingdom of God. These relationships have become vital, relevant, strong, and dynamic. Thank you CityFest!" With Space Coast CityFest acting as a catalyst, the movement has also been providing opportunities for the churches of Brevard County to set aside differences and unite in service. In an effort that has come to be known as CityServe Brevard, the churches are focusing on several areas of need including foster care and adoption, school partnerships, ending homelessness and hunger, helping at-risk families and neighborhood revitalization, and bringing awareness to the opioid crisis and mental health.

While local leaders continue in this effort, the Palau Association will move on to support similar campaigns in cities across the globe. 

radically saved on that airplane and delivered from cocaine without one bit of withdrawal.

However, the hard work wasn't over. Carmen still faced the challenge of going home to face Jon. He had been raised in the church and was saved at a young age. In his older years, he grew away from the faith. When Carmen told Jon she had been saved, he knew exactly what it meant, but he wasn't quite ready to make a change. Something told her she needed to keep distance from him while he was still involved, so she made a commitment to continue working on her relationship with the Lord. Eventually, Jon admitted he couldn't break away from the addiction and lifestyle while they were still in Florida, and they moved back to Duluth. It was there that Carmen saw Jon soften. The prosecutors were determined to send Jon to prison, but the presiding judge stated he could see Jon was a changed man. He was sentenced to a one-year work release program and a few years of probation. The felony charge was dropped. The Lord blessed them, and they slowly began to get their lives in order. They started a small business of buying and fixing up houses. They joined a wonderful church with a loving pastor and made many supportive friends. Carmen and Jon are so thankful for that Bible. It was in exactly the place Carmen needed it to be. There is no denying God was with her during those hours in the hotel room and on that plane ride. Throughout her life. God has always drawn her back to the Scriptures, and the power of His Word continues to show up.






