Knesset Unified Around One Goal: Ousting Netanyahu

Israel's political leaders in the Knesset are attempting to form a "unity" government among numerous political factions but that plan is being viewed as a naked attempt to shove aside the country's long-serving prime minister.

Political opponents of Benjamin Netanyahu are hoping for a quick vote in the Knesset to approve a newly-announced coalition government and formally end his 12-year rule. That major political change would come after the prime minister, dogged by corruption charges, has failed to form a coalition after several weeks of trying.

Meanwhile, The Associated Press reports that opposition leader Yair Lapid and his main coalition partner, Naftali Bennett,



have announced a deal to form a new government and muster a majority in the 120-member Knesset. The coalition's makeup is problematic, consisting of eight parties from across the political spectrum, including right wingers previously allied with Netanyahu, center-left parties, and even an Arab faction.

Reacting to Israel's newest political moves, Mike Pompeo told Fox News that creating unity

with Arab parties and hard-right parties will be "really difficult" to pull off.

"And that's not good," the former secretary of state advised. "It's not good for the U.S.-Israel relationship."

McGeachin Meets With President Trump in NYC

(NEW YORK, New York)
— Idaho Lt. Governor Janice McGeachin met with President Donald Trump on Monday to discuss important issues related to our country, the state of Idaho, and their united efforts to push back against the radical left's attempts to indoctrinate America's schoolchildren with some of the most toxic and anti-American theories ever conceived.

McGeachin's meeting at Trump Tower in New York City followed her appearance on the Fox News Channel's "Tucker Carlson Show" earlier this month regarding her efforts to block these teachings in Idaho schools, after which Trump personally called to praise her performance and thank her for her leadership on the issue. This call inspired McGeachin to meet with Trump personally to discuss these vitally important matters.

In 2020, President Trump established the 1776 Commission, which released The 1776 Report in January of 2021. This report presented "a definitive chronicle of the American founding, a powerful description of the effect the principles of the Declaration of Independence have had on this Nation's history, and a dispositive rebuttal of reckless 're-education' attempts that seek to reframe American history around the idea that the United States is not an exceptional country but an evil one."

Earlier this month, President Trump laid out a bold, seven-point plan to reform the America's education system and to help young people "discover that America is the greatest, most tolerant, and most generous nation



in history."

"It was an honor to meet with President Trump and in turn thank him for his unwavering leadership and commitment to put America first and keep America great," McGeachin said after returning to Idaho. "President Trump at great personal cost fought not only our enemies abroad, but he also had to fight the increasingly socialist Democratic Party and even some from within his own Republican Party to preserve our values,

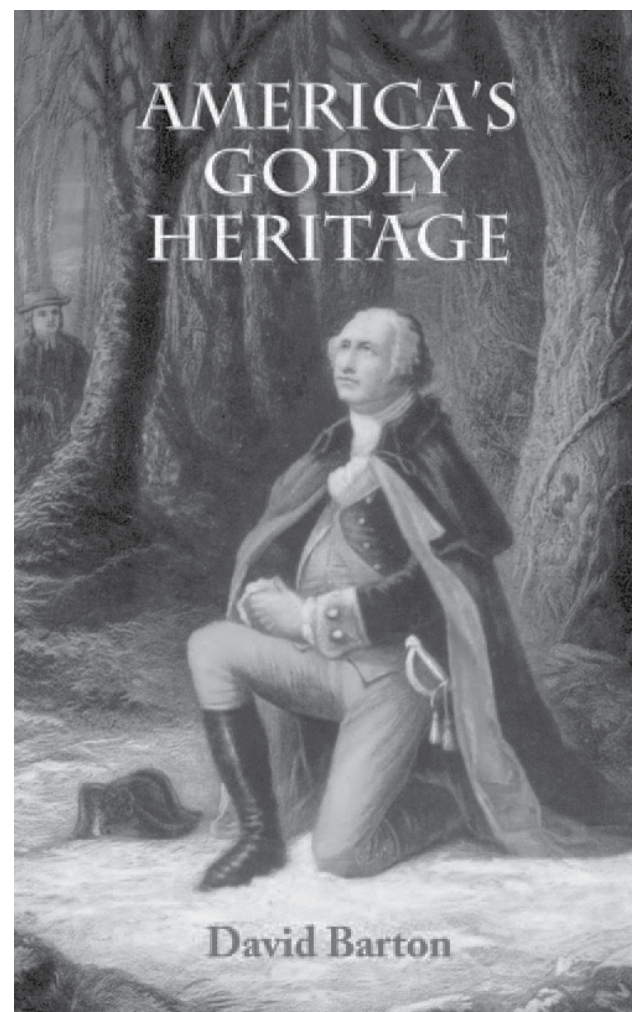
rejuvenate our economy, and secure our southern border. I assured him as the Lt. Governor of Idaho, I am working to uphold the principles he espouses and to support his ongoing efforts to elevate the inspiring truths of America's history."

McGeachin has a strong history of support for Trump, beginning during the 2016 Republican presidential primary.

After the election, McGeachin took the lead in authoring and submitting an amicus brief in support of a lawsuit filed by the Attorney General of Texas. The lawsuit urged the U.S. Supreme Court to block the certification of presidential election results in multiple swing states, which the suit alleged had violated not only federal election law but also their own state election laws. That case was later dismissed.

Faith and Endurance: A Decade of Hostility From the Left

Christian baker Jack Phillips has openly shared about what he calls the “horrific” backlash he has faced over the years since being sued for declining to bake two men’s same-sex “wedding” cake due to his sincerely held religious beliefs.



From death threats to the vandalism of his Denver, Colorado, cake shop, to being sued all the way to the U.S. Supreme Court, Phillips – the owner of Masterpiece Cakeshop – has had to endure many attacks for standing up for his faith against the Left

and its LGBTQ activists.

“The emails [and] the phone calls were sometimes horrific – you’d just hear profanity,” Phillips shared in a recent “Edifi with Billy Hallowell” podcast interview. “We had our store vandalized ... we had death threats. I had a guy call me up one day, said he was in his car, he’s got a gun, he’s on his way to the shop, and he’s going to blow my head off.”

Eventually, the bakery owner had to take all of the incoming phone calls to protect his staff – and with nearly a decade passing since the fateful day that ushered in continuous harassment, Phillips decided to share his story in his new book, “The Cost of My Faith,” beginning when two men tried to order their wedding cake in 2012.

“I sat down, I introduced myself ... I immediately knew what my answer would be,” Phillips recounted before respectfully turning their request down: “I’m sorry, guys, I don’t do cakes for same-sex weddings.”

The visibly frustrated homosexual couple then angrily stormed out of the bakery.

Letter To The Editor

The “critical race theory” is hogwash. All humans are one race—human. There are different people groups, but anatomically, under our outer covering, we all have the same anatomical structures.

As humans are inherently evil, the strong began to dominate (enslave) the weak. People also began to regard those who were different as inferior to themselves, and the “superior” began to dominate the “inferior.”

The Bible casually mentions some people with different shades of skin. Esau was reddish. 1 Samuel 16:13 says David was “ruddy” (brown). Ethiopians (black skinned people) are mentioned often, and Jeremiah 13:23 asks, “Can the Ethiopian change his skin?” Song of Solomon 1:5-6 quotes his beloved twice saying she is “dark.” Acts 13:1 mentions several leaders of the church including “Simeon who was called Niger.” (“Niger” [like Nigger] means “Black.”)

It was not until African Blacks were captured by other Blacks, sold to Whites, and brought to the Americas for slave labor that Whites developed the idea of race. This resulted from Darwin’s fictional evolutionary tree of different peoples with Whites at the top and Blacks at the bottom.

The Bible says that God “made from one blood every nation” (Acts 16:26). We are all descended not only from Adam, but also from Noah. His sons’ descendants populated the entire earth: Japheth’s went west to Europe, Ham’s went south to Africa, and Shem’s went east to the Orient. Inter-marrying with relatives, their DNA resulted to localized differences. But the fact is, we are all related in the human race.

After the Civil War the South was divided with Reconstruction. The KKK was established as an arm

of the Democrat party and used lynching to enforce Democrat voting. They lynched Whites (Republicans) as well as Blacks. The last documented lynching by the KKK was 19-year-old Michael Donald in 1981 in Mobile, Alabama. 2020 had numerous reports of Black men found hanging, supposedly suicides, but regarded by Blacks as lynchings.

Aboriginal people were displayed in Human Zoos as evidence of evolution until at least 1940. Original people were captured to be exhibited alongside animals across Europe and North America.

During the Tulsa “Race” Massacre (1921), White residents burned to the ground more than 35 square blocks of Greenwood, a predominantly Black area with a population of 10,000, leaving perhaps 300 dead. Destroyed were 108 business establishments including 2 newspapers, 41 groceries and meat markets, 30 cafes and restaurants, offices for 33 professionals including 15 physicians and attorneys, clothing stores, funeral parlors, billiard halls, hotels, barbershops, hairdressers, shoemakers, tailors, nightclubs, two movie theaters, a library, and a hospital. This was because America accepted Darwinian evolution that Blacks were inferior and undesirable.

Some of this was, of course, the result of sinful hearts, but much was the result of Darwin’s disastrous teaching of evolution which is both irrational and unscientific.

Abari's story



Abari beams positivity as he reflects on the events of his life. He has always had an optimistic outlook—a mindset that stems from his mother and the way he was raised.

Abari was born in Chicago. He lived in Sioux Falls, Iowa for a few years and then spent the rest of his childhood in Evans, Colorado.

When Abari was a child, his parents separated, but his mother always reminded him that he was loved and that he could accomplish anything in life. She also taught him the importance of treating people with kindness and giving back to the community.

“I grew up meeting a lot of different people of different cultures,” Abari said. “My mother brought us up to not base our outlook and opinions on race or how people looked, but to judge them by their works, how they act and how they treat you.”

His mother worked in the medical field, which taught Abari the importance of helping people. When Abari moved to Denver, he wanted to find a way to volunteer on his days off from his job at a marketing research company and found Denver Rescue Mission as an opportunity to get involved. Abari enjoyed volunteering at the Mission and wanted to simply give back to others.

“I’ve really enjoyed meeting a lot of the staff here and seeing that they’re enjoying helping people,” he said. “It’s really inspiring to me.”

Abari ended up losing both his job and his home abruptly. He found himself staying in hotel rooms until he found a place in Aurora, which was a completely different experience for him.

“It wasn’t horrible, but Colfax is only like six blocks south of that, and every now and then you hear gunshots and a lot of activity,” described Abari, “so I ended up just leaving there, and that’s when I started coming here [to DRM].”

Now, Abari is working on prioritizing his goals and plans for the future.

Music is a passion that has always been a part of Abari’s life. Growing up, he played the standup acoustic bass as well as several other instruments. He excelled at an early age and joined the Greeley Chamber Orchestra as a teenager and played with the Colorado Symphony Orchestra.

“At one point, I think I was probably in six or seven different groups,” he said. “I was going around the state, sometimes outside of [the] state. Everything I was doing was pretty much just music based, and it got so overwhelming to where I just started cancelling everything. But now that I’m older, I’m debating whether or not I want to venture off into that again, but with a different perspective. It still is something that’s a part of me and something that I love.”

Abari also loves the arts, including music, drawing, sculpting, and film. But one of his main passions is helping people. His innate nature to give

back to others, along with his experience volunteering at the Mission, has inspired him to consider applying to become a Peer Navigator, a Mission staff member who has personally experienced homelessness, so that he can encourage others to find hope and pursue their dreams.

“With my experience and what I’ve learned, I want to try to help somebody achieve, pursue or develop their aspirations,” he said.

Abari reflects on why he chooses to give back to his community and why he remains positive for whatever the future has in store for him. It all goes back to his faith.

Having a father with an Israeli Hebrew background and a Christian mother, Abari grew up in the church learning about Jesus. Although he’s had life struggles that have tested his faith, he has always been a strong believer.

“I used to be involved in the drug scene, but I finally got that out of my life 20 years ago,” he said. “But the spiritual, religious background was always part of my life. That’s one of the things that carried me on.”

Just like Jesus showed kindness to the poor and the broken, Abari is doing his best to extend that same kindness to those around him. He chooses to trust God’s plan for his life, even when it can be hard to understand the path God is leading him on.

“I consider the Most High and the sacrifices that He took for us and mankind,” Abari said. “The least I could do is try to live like [Jesus]. I think that all things happen for a reason, and my Creator has deemed it necessary for me to be here, so I’m just trying to follow. I ask Him to guide me and open my eyes to understand what He’s trying to show me.”

But without connection to family, my addiction grew worse and I was selling drugs and using sex to get drugs and money. I was mired in a terrible life in Nevada. I felt I needed to get back to my children,

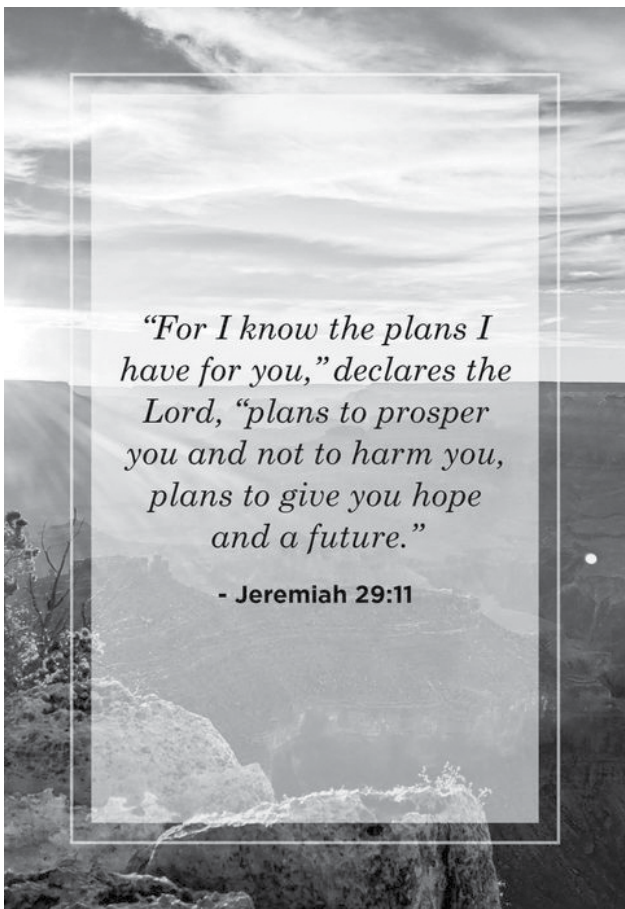
Pray this sincere prayer, meaning it with all your heart, and God will give you eternal life, right now!

Naftali Bennett (Hebrew: נפתלי בנעט, IPA: [nafta'li 'benet]; born 25 March 1972) is an Israeli politician serving as the 13th and current prime minister of Israel since 13 June 2021.[2] He served as Minister of Diaspora Affairs from 2013 to 2019, as Minister of Education from 2015 to 2019, and as Minister of Defense from 2019 to 2020. He has led the New Right party since 2018, having previously led The Jewish Home party between 2012 and 2018.[3]

Born and raised in Haifa, the son of immigrants from the United States, Bennett served in the Sayeret Matkal and Maglan special forces units of the Israel Defense Forces, commanding many combat operations, and subsequently became a software entrepreneur. In 1999, he co-founded and co-owned the US company Cyota. The company was sold in 2005 for \$145 million.[4] He has also served as CEO of Soluto, an Israeli cloud computing service, sold in 2013 for a reported \$100–130 million.[5]

Bennett entered politics in 2006, serving as Chief of Staff for Benjamin Netanyahu until 2008. In 2011, together with Ayelet Shaked, he co-founded the My Israel extra-parliamentary movement.[6] In 2012, Bennett was elected as the party leader of The Jewish Home. In the 2013 Knesset election, the first contested by The Jewish Home under Bennett's leadership, the party won 12 seats out of 120.[7] He served under Prime Minister Netanyahu as Minister of Economy and Religious Services from 2013 to 2015, before being appointed as Minister of Education in 2015. In December 2018, Bennett defected from The Jewish Home to form the New Right, a member of the Yamina alliance.[8] After he lost his Knesset seat in the April 2019 Knesset election, he was dismissed by Netanyahu as Education Minister in June 2019. He regained his seat in the September 2019 Knesset election and was appointed Minister of Defense, before leaving the position the following year. In 2020, Bennett succeeded Shaked to become the leader of the Yamina alliance. On 2 June 2021, Bennett agreed to a rotation government with Yair Lapid, whereby Bennett would serve as Israel's Prime Minister until 2023, after which Lapid would assume the role until 2025.[9] Bennett was sworn in on 13 June 2021.[10]

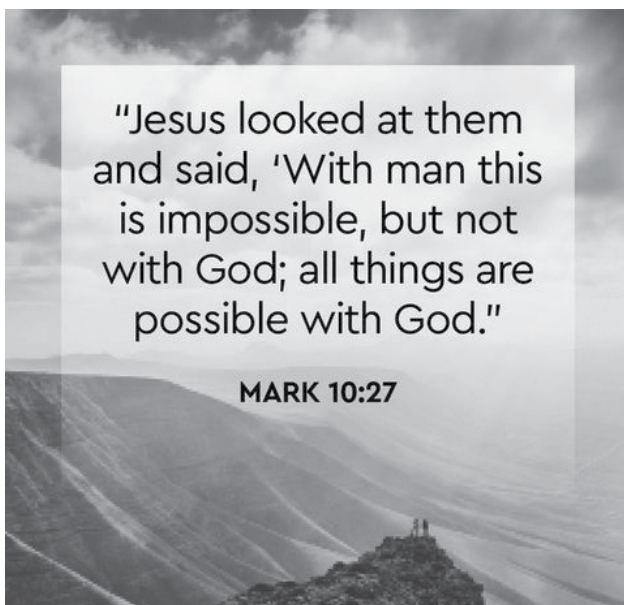

Translating God’s Word



“The words of the Lord are pure words; Like silver refined in a furnace on the ground, filtered seven times.” (Psalm 12:6)

Even where the work is done by sincere Christians with good intentions, the effect of such “translations” is to subvert the Word of God to the second-guessing of fallible men, a disturbing trend that obscures the full truth of Scripture to those seeking God.

During a White House press conference Monday June 21, there was a news reporter that asked Press Secretary Jennifer Psaki the following questions as related to President Biden’s participation in the Catholic Church Communion. Here are those news reporter questions below, but no mention of the scripture reference from The Holy Bible 1 Corinthians 11:29-30 that is the basis for their concerns.

“Q Thank you, Jen. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops is writing a document to clarify who should receive Communion. And this is targeted at politicians, people who have a high public profile. What’s the President’s reaction to this?

MS. PSAKI: Well, Joe Biden is a strong man of faith. And as he noted just a couple of days ago, it’s personal. He goes to church, as you know, nearly every weekend. He even went when we were on our overseas trip. But it’s personal to him. He doesn’t see it through a political prism. And we’re not going to comment otherwise on the inner workings of the Catholic Church.

Q Would statements by the bishops make the

President reconsider his public support for policies that, you know, increase access to abortion or allow access to abortion in the United States?

MS. PSAKI: Again, that the President’s faith is personal. It’s something that has helped guide him through some challenging moments in his life. And that’s how many Americans see their faith as well, not through a political prism. So I would suspect he will continue to attend church as he has for many, many years.

Q Does he realize that —

MS. PSAKI: Go ahead, Jonathan.

Q — his stance on abortion runs contradictory to U.S. CCB teachings?

MS. PSAKI: Go ahead. I think we’re going to move on to the next question because I’ve just answered that and it’s personal.”

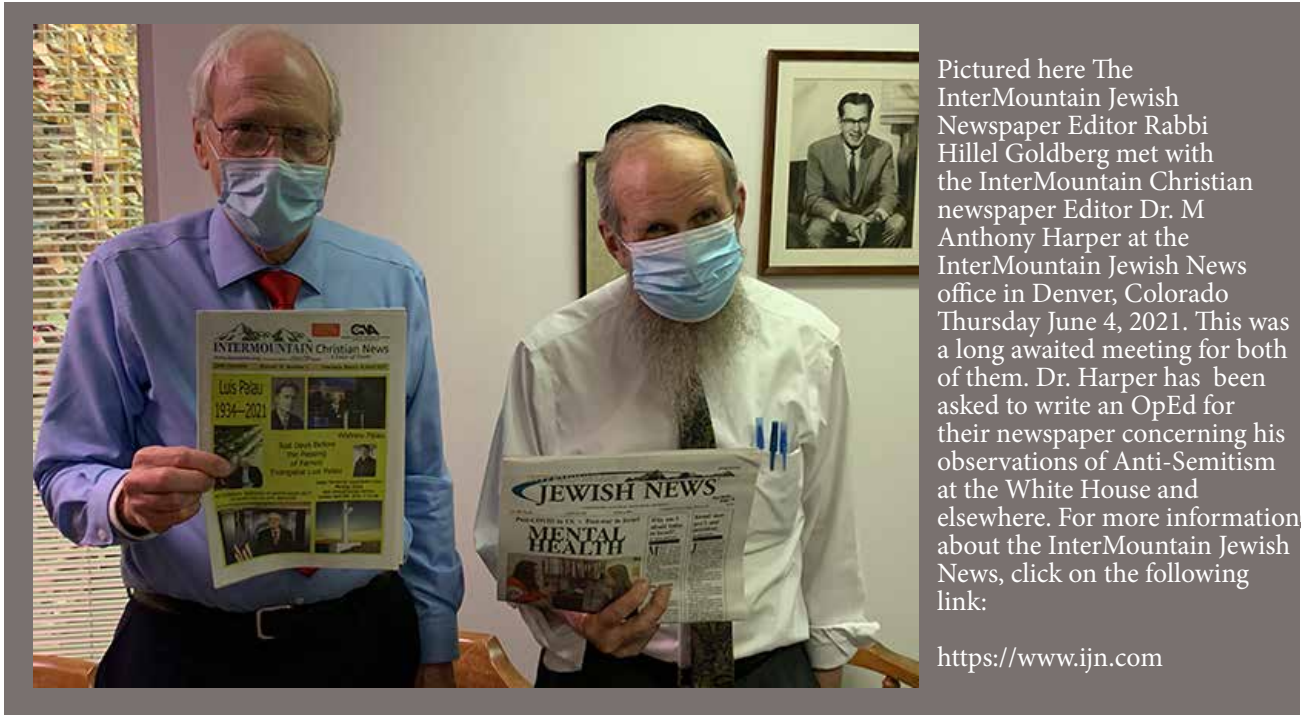

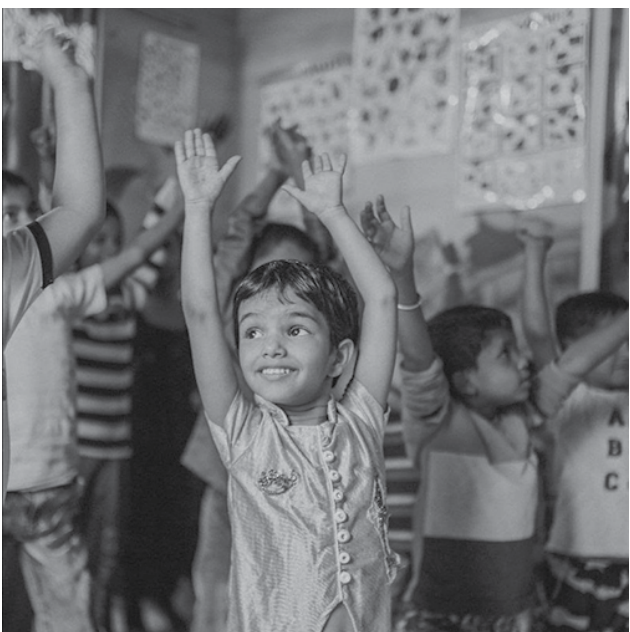

Knesset Unified Around One Goal: Ousting Netanyahu

David Rubin, an Israel-based national security analyst, tells One News Now that Bennett leads the Yamina Party, which means “to the right” in Hebrew.

“And unfortunately he seems to be going to the left,” Rubin complains. “He is forming a coalition which will have a majority of its members from left-wing parties.”

What is uniting the Knesset members is their opposition to Netanyahu and their determination to end his political career, Rubin advises. That determination is demonstrated, he adds, by Bennett’s party holding only six of 120 seats yet he is on track to become prime minister for two years as part of the plan.

Gordon Klingenschmitt, a former military chaplain, has been observing Israel’s politics and says Bennett ran on a conservative platform that included supporting Netanyahu.

“Instead he did an about face,” he says of the Yamina leader, “and now he is basically giving control of the government to the liberals with the exchange that Bennett becomes prime minister.”

“I hope that whatever government ultimately forms --- that’s the Israeli’s business,” Pompeo told Fox News, “they’ll continue to build out on what we did, which really created more peace, more prosperity, and indeed more stability in the Middle East.”

In another AFR radio interview, Jan Markell of Olive Tree Ministries predicted the names being

floated to replace Netanyahu will fall short because he is “irreplaceable” as leader.

“He is constantly looking out for Israel’s welfare. He will never compromise,” she said of the long-serving prime minister. “He will never cave to anybody, and he certainly won’t cave to the Iranians.”

“[Naftali Bennett’s] views are to the right [But] the views of his coalition are not to the right; the views of his coalition are more to the left. So, he’s going to have to do a balancing act walking a tightrope for his entire time as prime minister. It’s not going to be easy.”

“He’s going to have pressure [from President Joe Biden for a two-state solution] – and he’s also going to have the pressure from the majority of his coalition that is going to agree with Biden and is going to be pushing for a Palestinian terrorist state. So, Bennett is putting himself in a position where he’s going to be hostage to not only a left-wing president who will be pressuring him all the time, but also a left-wing coalition in Israel.”

accept that the coronavirus could easily travel between hosts, that people could get sick by asymptomatic spread, and that masks could prevent the virus from spreading. For most demographics, the co-author admits, his initial discernment was fitting.

“But something changed,” Erzen notes. “It appears his level of possible complicity in what went on in the Wuhan lab may very well have been the catalyst.”

Fauci – director of the U.S. National Institute of Allergy and Infectious Diseases – became the “poster child” for what Erzen considers to be a movement that kept building momentum, progressively taking away the normalcy of American life as the country once knew it.

“[Fauci] is what happens when bureaucracy runs wild and does not serve the people, but [serves] its interests – and its interests alone.”

“[Fauci] is the peak of what is possible when ‘we the people’ relinquish the duties and responsibilities of those citizens who are supposed to be the backbone of our Republic,” the author contends.

“No matter what expert is given a level of authority that is not supposed to be theirs, they will ultimately worship the idol that they crave the most,” he continues,

arguing that it’s rarely in the best interest of the people.

“At best, [Fauci] basically became the president of the United States,” he concludes. “And at worst, a religious, cult figure.”

The co-host to the Steve Deace Show suggests that regardless of a person’s field of expertise, a degree of accountability “more specific and more stern” is required than for those who are considered non-experts. “If [one wants] that level of pedigree and everything that comes with it – fame, fortune, authority – he should be held accountable for his failures,” he adds.

An opinion piece written by Senator Marsha Blackburn (R-Tennessee) makes it clear she’s in agreement with Erzen. It is her desire to hold many to account ... e.g., the Chinese Communist Party, the World Health Organization, and public health officials – including Fauci. But no one – including the media – has held the doctor accountable, Erzen notes.

“[The media] has turned him into a demigod,” he states, arguing that very early on, Fauci knew that he could get away with nearly anything.

Fauci, says Erzen, needs to be held to account by President Biden and the American people for his claims that some argue continue to harm the country.

who had since gone to live with their grandpa and aunt in Lehi, Utah.

I traveled to Utah to see if I could reconnect with my family, but I was really in no shape for a homecoming. I was not taking the prescription medication I needed to manage my bi-polar disorder and was using illegal street drugs, such as meth.

I was homeless and when I had a severe depressive episode, I was hospitalized. As I recovered, the hospital staff asked me if I had a place to go when I was released. I really had nowhere but as I was lying there, a phone number came into my mind. It was a phone number I had called a few times before to seek help when I was homeless. It was the number to the Rescue Mission's Women's Center.

I asked the hospital staff to call the number and when the Rescue Mission answered I told them I needed help and a place to stay. They agreed to give me a chance on their New Life Program, and so I arrived at the Mission on May 14, 2020.

The biggest thing I had to accept in joining the program was that it was 13 months of my life. I thought, "what's going to happen to my children. What about the few belongings I still have. How will this impact my future relationships with everyone knowing I had been in a long-term recovery program?"

But God gave me the strength to commit. It was hard to tell my family about my decision. It embarrassed me because although they knew I JOY struggles, I don't think they realized how bad my life had become until I told them I was joining the Rescue Mission's program. Still, being honest about how broken I was a huge first step for me.

As I worked through the New Life Recovery Program, I found that it was filled with counselors and staff and other program members who genuinely cared about being my friend. It seemed like they wanted to have a real relationship and even friendship with me, not just work through a series of counseling questions.

I found that real companionship can blossom and even grow during recovery. It was not 13-months of constant struggle, it was enjoyable at times, too. I say "at times" because certainly there were difficulties and frustrations. I was challenged to get to the bottom of my issues. To forgive those who hurt me in the past and, in turn, accept forgiveness for the wrong things I have done. And, most importantly, to truly accept Jesus and what He did by providing eternal forgiveness for us on the cross.

I love attending my home church of Calvary Baptist and learning more about Jesus. I need that connection to my church because I need people in my life who will encourage me to stay close to Jesus. As God has changed me over this past year, He has also been faithful to restore my relationships with my children and family.

My children view my word as trustworthy now. They believe the things I tell them and trust that I am able to follow through. They are thriving living with their aunt and step-grandfather in Lehi.

One way God has blessed us is that I never lost custody of my children. They are under a temporary guardianship now, but I will be able to have full custody again when I graduate the New Life Program.

I am currently saving money so I can get a small apartment where my kids and I can live together. When I moved to the employment phase of the New Life Program, God provided me with a good job at a Maverik Country Store just a few blocks from the Rescue Mission's Women's Center. After two months I was promoted to shift lead. Maverik is a good, stable company with great benefits, so I feel blessed to work there.

I am hoping to be able to transfer to a store in Lehi or somewhere in northern Utah County when I graduate because I would like to move there so my kids and I can be close to the rest of our family who have been so instrumental in raising them.

Even as I look forward to living with my kids again, I know I need to take everything slow and not forget to take steps each day to seek the fellowship with God and His people that I need to stay sober. My mental health is doing so much better and, with the correct prescription and sobriety, my bi-polar disorder is well controlled. I know God's healing has been a part of that as well.

Please pray for me as I make the transition out of the Rescue Mission's New Life Program and work to reunite with my children, who are 12, 9, and 4. I feel like as long as we are together and have God in our lives, that is all that matters. Thank you for supporting the Rescue Mission and giving me another chance to be a mom and a sober person again who knows Jesus.

Faith and Endurance: A Decade of Hostility From the Left

“I was stunned. I tried to be polite,” the Christian baker recalled. “I tried to – in that couple of sentences – let them know that I’d be happy to serve them in any other capacity ... but this was a cake that, because of the message and my faith, I couldn’t create.”

Before long, Phillips’ life would never be the same. He vividly remembers that 20 minutes did not pass before his phone began ringing and emails started bombarding his inbox.

The baker’s polite exchange quickly evolved into a national debate, and the state of Colorado sued him three months later in October, when he was told that he must check his Christian faith at his bakery’s door.

“The [Colorado Civil Rights Commission] required me to change my policies, ignore my faith,” Phillips explained. “And [they told me] when I’m at the cake shop, I don’t get to exercise my freedom of religion.”

The culinary artist was basically told he had no control over his creations – similar to an author being told she has no freedom over what she writes.

“The baker said he would have had no rights over the design of his cakes and that the incident would force him to report to the Commission quarterly for two years as he retrained his staff to meet government standards,” The Christian Post (CP) explained. “Phillips stood his ground and battled the government in court.”

Soon, however, he had to shut down a major part of his business. “We decided that the way around it was not to create wedding cakes at all,” Phillips noted. “We were doing probably 300 wedding cakes every year, but we had to give that up.”

After the state of Colorado dealt Phillip’s business major blows in court, the U.S. Supreme Court ended up reversing the outcome in 2018.

“The Supreme Court ruled in Phillips’s favor in a 7–2 decision,” the National Association of Christian Ministers (NACM) recounted. “They didn’t render a decision on the broader issues of the case, but they did find that the Colorado Civil Rights Commission ‘showed elements of a clear and impermissible hostility toward the sincere religious beliefs motivating his objection.’”

It was made clear that the LGBTQ community cannot take away Christians’ First Amendment rights.

“The laws and the Constitution can, and in some instances must, protect gay persons and gay couples in the exercise of their civil rights, but religious and philosophical objects to gay marriage are protected views, and in some instances, protected forms of expression,” the opinion from Phillip’s Supreme Court case explained.

But the LGBTQ community clearly isn’t done with Phillips in court. “Phillips still faces the fallout from a separate 2017 instance in which a customer contacted the bakery and asked for a cake to celebrate a gender transition – something Phillips declined,” CP noted. “He has since been back in court to battle over that incident.”

After nearly a decade of exhausting legal battles, Phillips finds the strength to carry on through his faith in Jesus Christ.

“God has provided everything we needed all the way through,” Phillips shared, according to CP.

And he would like his family to take away one thing from the ongoing saga:

“[I would] like for them to look and not say that I was a big political guy, but that I was a follower of Jesus Christ and did my best in my work and family and life and all of my relationships to reflect that relationship with the Savior of the world.”

Today, we remember and celebrate the role that the healing balm of prayer can play in our lives and in the life of our Nation. As we continue to confront the crises and challenges of our time — from a deadly pandemic, to the loss of lives and livelihoods in its wake, to a reckoning on racial justice, to the existential threat of climate change — Americans of faith can call upon the power of prayer to provide hope and uplift us for the work ahead. As the late Congressman John Lewis once said, “Nothing can stop the power of a committed and determined people to make a difference in our society. Why? Because human beings are the most dynamic link to the divine on this planet.”

On this National Day of Prayer, we unite with purpose and resolve, and recommit ourselves to the core freedoms that helped define and guide our Nation from its earliest days. We celebrate our incredible good fortune that, as Americans, we can exercise our convictions freely — no matter our faith or beliefs. Let us find in our prayers, however they are delivered, the determination to overcome adversity, rise above our differences, and come together as one Nation to meet this moment in history.

The Congress, by Public Law 100-307, as amended, has called on the President to issue each year a proclamation designating the first Thursday in May as a “National Day of Prayer.”

NOW, THEREFORE, I, JOSEPH R. BIDEN JR., President of the United States of America, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Constitution and the laws of the United States, do hereby proclaim May 6, 2021, as a National Day of Prayer. I invite the citizens of our Nation to give thanks, in accordance with their own faiths and consciences, for our many freedoms and blessings, and I join all people of faith in prayers for spiritual guidance, mercy, and protection.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have hereunto set my hand this fifth day of May, in the year of our Lord two thousand twenty-one, and of the Independence of the United States of America the two hundred and forty-fifth.

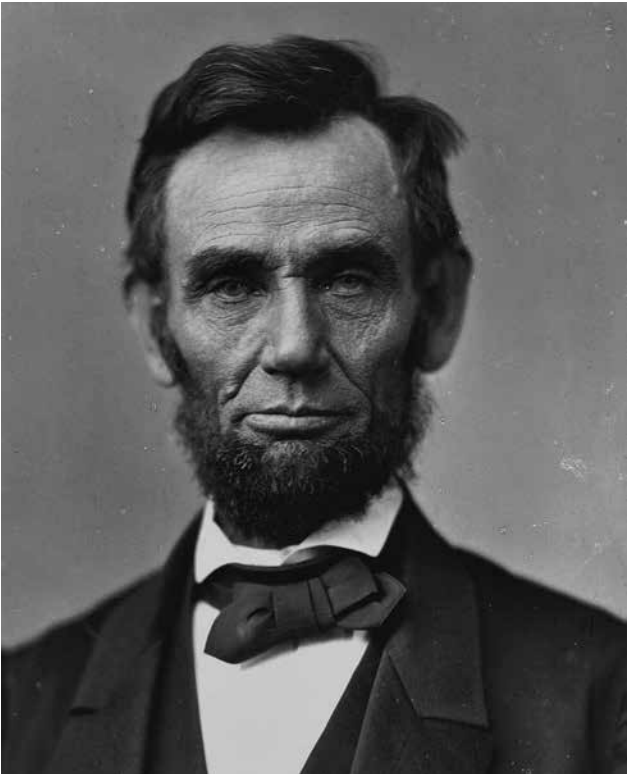

**Proclamation Appointing a National Fast Day
Washington, D.C.
March 30, 1863**

By the President of the United States of America.

A Proclamation.

Whereas, the Senate of the United States, devoutly recognizing the Supreme Authority and just Government of Almighty God, in all the affairs of men and of nations, has, by a resolution, requested the President to designate and set apart a day for National prayer and humiliation.

And whereas it is the duty of nations as well as of men, to own their dependence upon the overruling power of God, to confess their sins and transgressions, in humble sorrow, yet with assured hope that genuine repentance will lead to mercy and pardon; and to recognize the sublime truth, announced in the Holy Scriptures and proven by all history, that those nations only are blessed whose God is the Lord.

And, inasmuch as we know that, by His divine law, nations like individuals are subjected to punishments and chastisements in this world, may we not justly fear that the awful calamity of civil war, which now desolates the land, may be but a punishment, inflicted upon us, for our presumptuous sins, to the needful end of our national reformation as a whole People? We have been the recipients of the choicest bounties of Heaven. We have been preserved, these many years, in peace and prosperity. We have grown in numbers, wealth and power, as no other nation has ever grown. But we have forgotten God. We have forgotten the gracious hand which preserved us in peace, and multiplied and enriched and strengthened us; and we have vainly imagined, in the deceitfulness of our hearts, that all these blessings were produced by some superior wisdom and virtue of our own. Intoxicated with unbroken success, we have become too self-sufficient to feel the necessity of redeeming and preserving grace, too proud to pray to the God that made us!

It behooves us then, to humble ourselves before the offended Power, to confess our national sins, and to pray for clemency and forgiveness.

Now, therefore, in compliance with the request, and fully concurring in the views of the Senate, I do, by this my proclamation, designate and set apart Thursday, the 30th. day of April, 1863, as a day of national humiliation, fasting and prayer. And I do hereby request all the People to abstain, on that day, from their ordinary secular pursuits, and to unite, at their several places of public worship and their respective homes, in keeping the day holy to the Lord, and devoted to the humble discharge of the religious duties proper to that solemn occasion.

All this being done, in sincerity and truth, let us then rest humbly in the hope authorized by the Divine teachings, that the united cry of the Nation will be heard on high, and answered with blessings, no less than the pardon of our national sins, and the restoration of our now divided and suffering Country, to its former happy condition of unity and peace.

In witness whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the seal of the United States to be affixed.

Done at the City of Washington, this thirtieth day of March, in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and sixty-three, and of the Independence of the United States the eighty seventh.

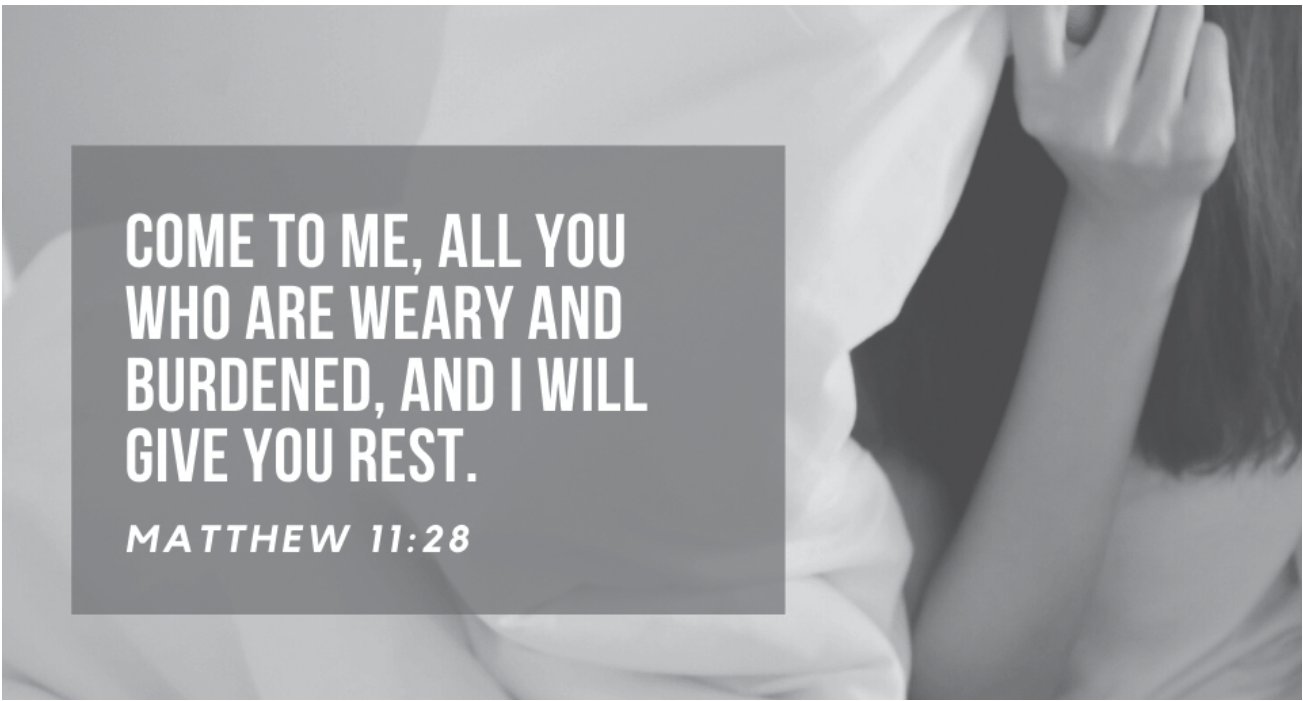


